Lansing, Aug. 25—The appointment of six "master trappers" who will be available to instruct livestock owners and ranchers in the fine points of coyote and wolf trapping is announced by the department of conservation.

The trappers are as follows: Herbert Lenon Gulliver, and Paul J. Houlmont, Alpha, who will be assigned to the Marquette regional conservation office in the Upper Peninsula, Lawrence S. Manier, Wilburn Adair and Grant Thompson, of Atlanta and Orla A. Hayner Munith who will be assigned to regional conservation headquarters at Roscommon.

Livestock owners wanting special advice or instruction in trapping coyotes or wolves may apply through their local county agent for a master trapper. The county agent will file the application with conservation authorities in his region. In the Upper Peninsula such applications must be filed at Marquette and in the Lower Peninsula at Roscommon.

Raymond Adair, 86, of 125 N. Barlow Road, Harrisville, died Sunday, March 9, at Alpena General Hospital.

Mr. Adair was born August 18, 1893 in Lebanon, Indiana and came to Alcona County at the age of 16. He married Alice Rose Rushler in Killmaster April 18, 1918, and she died August 31, 1971. He later married Harriett Whitefield who also preceded him in death. In 1943 Mr. Adair was appointed Alcona County Sheriff, following the death of Sheriff George Wilson, and he held this position until his retirement in 1954. He spent the remainder of his active life farming.

He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Lincoln, the Michigan Sheriff's Association, and was an A.S.C. Committee member.




