







THREE CREEK COUNTY BOYS AMONG THEM—RALPH ADAMS WIRES SISTER IN BRISTOW OF HIS SAFETY.

Below we publish a list of the Oklahomans on the liner Tuscania which was torpedoed by a German submarine last week off the Irish coast. Ralph Adams, of Oilton, was among the Oklahoma boys and went to the army in the second contingent of the first draft. His sister, Mrs. E. Roberts of this city, received a wire Sunday from Adjt. General McCain that he was saved.

Ralph S. Adams Writes Sister Mrs. Roberts of Bristow— Is in England.

Ralph S. Adams, who was a soldier on the torpedoed Tuscania, in which many American boys lost their lives, was among the rescued as announced in the Record at the time. This week his sister in Bristow, Mrs. E. Roberts, received a card from him, which was posted at a training camp in England.

The message is as follows: Dear Sister and Brother:

I am safe. Was on the ship that was torpedoed, but was saved. Don't worry about me. for I am all right. Like it fine. Don't expect to receive much mail from me from now on. RALPH S. ADAMS, American Exped. Forces.


