In a double wedding ceremony solemnized Thursday, Miss Anna' Pearl Mitchell became the bride of Ervin Jennings Foster, and Miss Eleanor Jean Alexander became the bride of Capt. Earl W. Mitchell.

Mrs. Foster and Captain Mitchell are daughter and son of Mrs. Earl W. Mitchell, 1509 East Fifth Avenue, and the late Mr. Mitchell. Mrs. Mitchell is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Hugh Alexander of Cieveland, Ohio, and Mr. Foster is the son of E. J. Foster of Winfield, Tenn. The Rev. E. H. Hamilton and the Rev. Robert Wood officiated at the double wedding at 5:30 p. m. at Park City Presbyterian Church, which was decorated with candles and greenery. Mrs. Harry P. Bibee, pianist, and Mrs. J. Rogers Carroll, vocalist, furnished the nuptial music.






