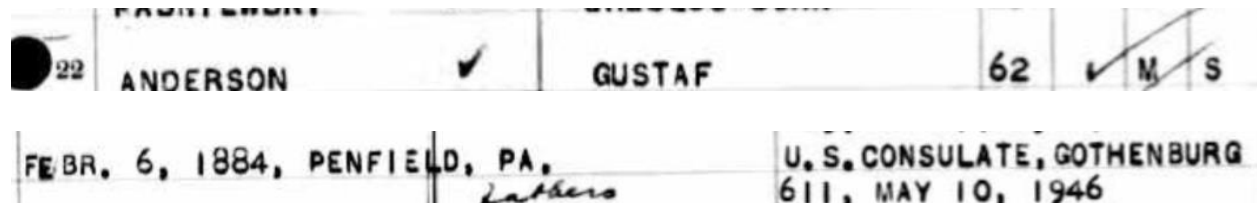

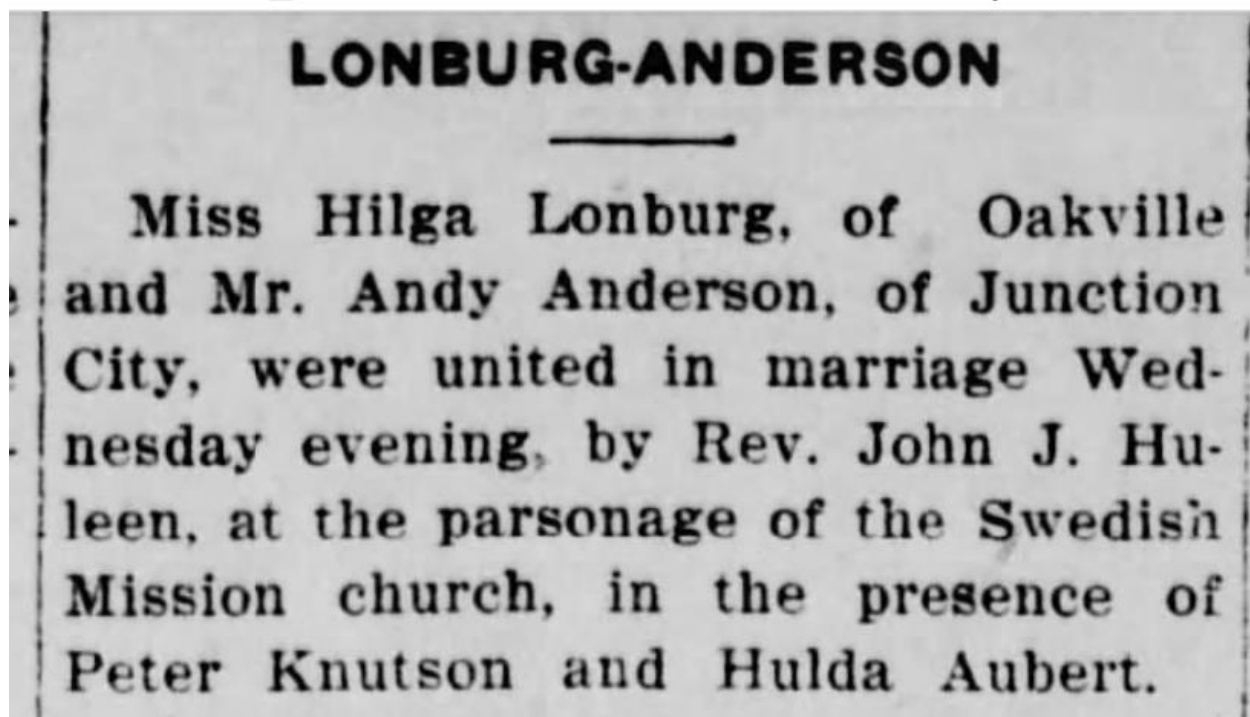

Left the US in July 1924. Apparently living in Sweden until returned aboard the "SS Gripsholm" which left Gothenburg, Sweden, on 14 May 1946 & arrived in New York City 26 May 1946. Passport #609 was issued to Gustaf Anderson, b. 6 Feb 1884 Penfield PA, age 62, by the US consulate in Gothenburg. His US address was Box 23, Junction City WA. (from "New York Passenger & Crew Lists")
