## Rudolph Carl Anderson

Rudolph Carl Anderson, 58, 1127 S. 1st West, retired machinist, died Thursday in a Salt Lake hospital after a lingering illness.

Born Dec. 9, 1888, in Sweden, a son of Axel and Amanda Brunzell Anderson, he came to the United States in 1890, residing in Minnesota until he enlisted in the army during World War I. He served with the 20th engineers, attaining the rank of sergeant. He was overseas 22 months.

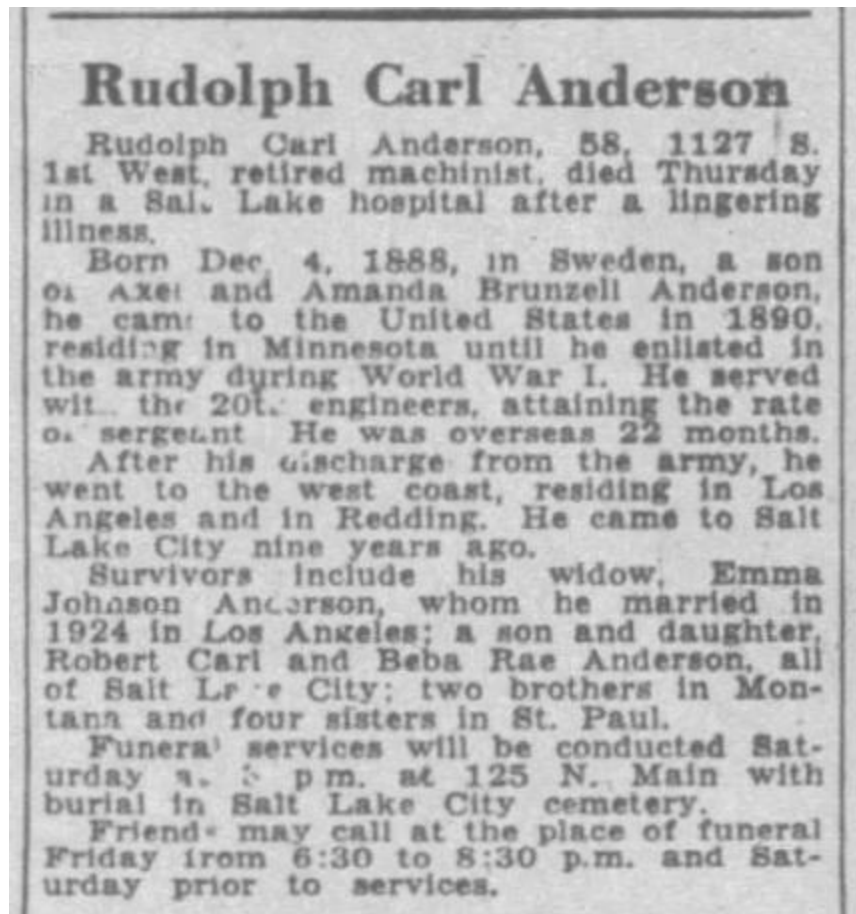
After his discharge from the army, he went to the west coast, residing in Los Angeles and in Redding. He came to Salt Lake City nine years ago.

Survivors include his widow, Emma Johnson Anderson, whom he married in 1924 in Los Angeles; a son and daughter, Robert Carl and Beba Rae Anderson, all of Salt Lake City, two brothers in Montana and four sisters in St. Paul.

Funeral services will be conducted Saturday at 3 p.m. at 125 N. Main, with burial in Salt Lake City cemetery.

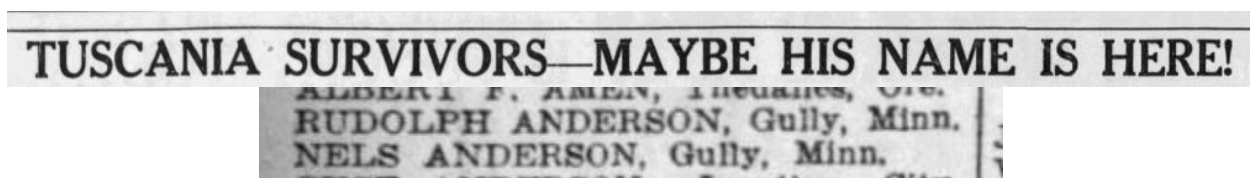

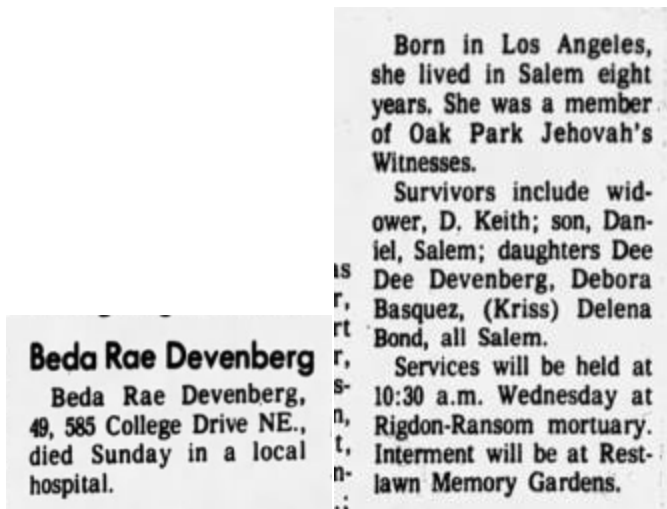
