

Funeral for Albert C. Anderson, 79, a retired home builder, will be at 11 a.m. tomorrow at Hazen and Jaeger's in the Valley. Private burial service will be at St. Joseph Cemetery.

Mr. Anderson died Tuesday at a local hospital.

Born in Minnesota, he came to Spokane in 1942 and was employed at the Farragut Naval Base during World War II. A self-employed contractor, he began building homes in the area after the war and retired about 10 years ago.

Mr. Anderson was a member of Carpenters Union Local 98 and a former member of the Spokane Home Builders Association.
