





The fact that the names of these Minneapolis and Minnesota men are announced in this list of those aboard the troop transport does not mean that they were among those lost. The number of men rescued is nearly 40 times those missing, and as no complete casualty list has been obtained, there is no present information their fate. The following Minneapolis men were on board the transport torpedoed: Rudolph E. Anderson, 3423 Elliot avenue. John Dogherty, 2301 Irving averue north. Emil F. Belvin, Lyndale avenue.



When he registered for the WWII draft, Roy lived at 2597 N. Cleveland Ave., Roseville, Ramsey MN with wife Pearl Mildred & was employed by North Western Bell Telephone Co. His death notice in the Minneapolis MN newspaper shows him residing at that address in Sep 1957. Pearl M. Anderson married James B. (marriage record) or R. (her Find A Grave record) on 29 Jun 1962 in Anoka Co. MN. She died as Pearl Nelson in Crosby, Crow Wing MN on 19 May 1986 & is buried in Hillside Cemetery, Minneapolis, Hennepin MN, F: 209708862.
