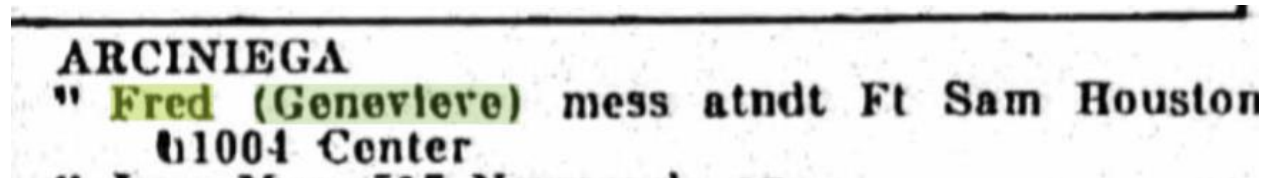

Nueve latinos más salvados en el hundimiento del día 5

WASHINGTON, Febrero 11.—En las listas adicionales de los supervivientes del trasatlántico "Tuscania", echado a pique el martes de la semana pasada frente a las costas irlandesas por un submarino alemán, figuran los nombres de otros noventa y dos soldados reclutados en el Estado de Texas, entre los que se encuentran nueve México-texanos, cuyos nombres son los siguientes:

Federico Arciniega, San Antonio; José R. Cisneros, San Marcos; Pablo González, Eldridge; Miguel Hernández, Laredo; Segundo Lucero, El Paso; Ramón Saldoval, Floresville; Juan Benavides, Paloma; Celestino Calderón, San Antonio, 102 San Francisco, Ave; Jesús Guzmán, Corpus Christi.

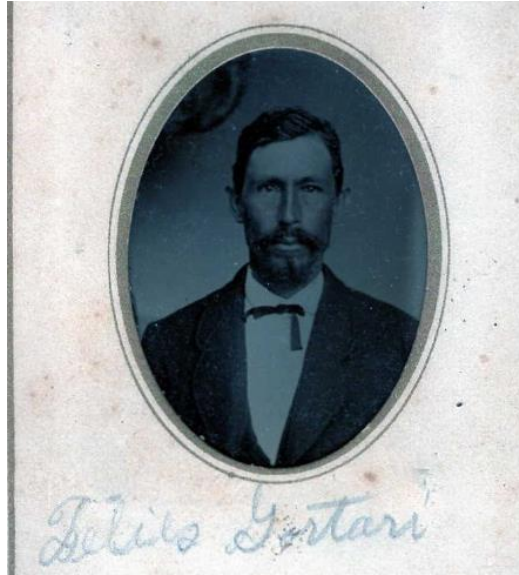

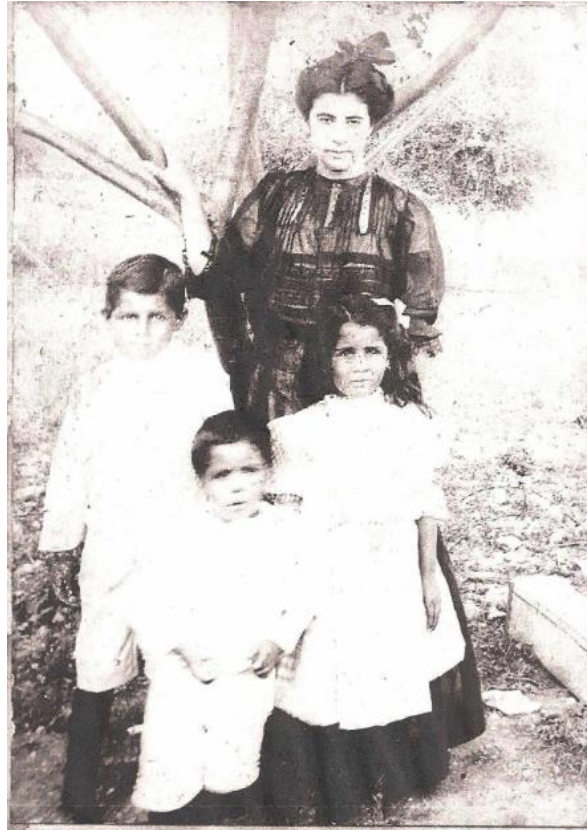
