Volunteers Entertain Oregon City Boys
—Odd Fellows' Lodge Visits Alberta
Lodge in Portland.

Milwaukie, Or., March 6.—The Milwaukie volunteer fire department has re-elected Charles C. Mullan chief for the coming year. Dan Mazzie, a foreman last year, has been elected assistant chief, succeeding Leo Shindler. Peter Audsted was re-elected president, W. A. Hanson was elected secretary, succeeding Edward Winzenreid, and Ralph Cooper was re-elected treasurer.

Arthur Webster, re-elected, and Leo Johnson, succeeding Jack Penni, are the new foremen of company No. 1, L. Warren, re-elected, and L. J. Roberts, succeeding Dan Mazzie, are the new foremen of company No. 2.

The Milwaukie volunteers entertained 25 members of the Oregon City volunteer fire department here Thursday night.

Some 50 members of Riverview Lodge No. 179, of Odd Fellows, visited Alberta lodge, Portland, Tuesday night in the series of visitations being conducted by the Odd Fellow lodges of Portland and vicinity. The series will wind up with a big rally of all the lodges to be held in Portland in the fall.

# MANY NORTHWEST MEN WERE ON BOARD TUSCANIA

Of Those on Doomed Craft When She Was Torpedoed by Submarine, Oregon Had Many.

SEVERAL PORTLAND BOYS

Whether Any of Them Are Among Missing Is Not Known; Most of Oregonians Were Engineers

Washington, Feb. 8.—Among those on board the torpedoed United States transport Tuscania were many Oregon and Washington men. It is not known whether any of them are among those missing. Most of the Oregonians are members of the Twentieth engineers. The list follows:

Wholesale revelries, accompanied by freely flowing liquor, under the roof of "chicken dinner" resorts east of Portland, were revealed in the early hours of Sunday morning when a joint force of federal and county authorities quietly descended upon Canary cottage, Taxicab Inn and Ilog Inn.

As a result several bottles of intoxicants are held in bondage by Sheriff Huriburt, and seven persons are under arrest on charges varying from maintaining a nuisance to disorderly conduct.

Canary cottage, conducted by Mrs. E. E. Powers and her son, R. B. Powers, at the site of the former Holly lodge on Foster road, a mile beyond Lents, gave shelter to a merry party of 10 couples when the joint raiding party arrived at 2 a. m. Sunday. Hard cider was much in evidence, and, according to official report, several bottles of the same were found in the kitchen. P. H. Andistad was arrested when two bottler of powerful apple juice were found on his person. An effort will be made today to secure a complaint against the place as a nuisance.

With evidence against Canary cottage safely flied the raiding party invaded. Taxicab inn, half a mile west of Rock-wood, and held its proprietor, Charles Gerring, at bay while Ormand Gowand was arrested by the federal detachment and gave up the two bottles of moonshine he carried. The federal agents took Gowand's car, which is subject to confiscation.

MERRY MAKING RUDELY ENDED BY RAIDERS

Federal and County Deputies Invade Canary Cottage, Taxicab and Ilog Inns Early Sunday and Take Guests and Liquor.

Ilog inn, conducted at Rockwood by H. B. Ilog, drew added attention from the raiding party when Mrs. H. Anderson, colored, and Mike Evinonoff were arrested on charges of disorderly conduct. Outside the building Ruth Ellis and Mike George were taken into custody on similar charges. Ilog was arrested for maintaining a disorderly house.

Six of the seven persons arrested furnished bail Sunday afternoon. Gowand, taken exclusively by the federal agents, is held in the county jail without bail. All will be called before a district judge some time Monday for arraignment.

Three government men, six county motorcycle police and Deputy Sheriffs Christofferson, Shermer and Kendall participated in the triple raid.

Tuesday morning Mrs. E. E. Powers and her son, R. B. Powers, who operate Canary cottage, pleaded not guilty to a charge of maintaining a nuisance and their request for a jury trial was granted. Trial was set for Monday. R. B. Powers, a soldier connected with a local recruiting office, appeared in court in his army uniform.

Monday afternoon Judge Bell assessed fines of \$10 each against Mrs. H. Anderson, colored, Ruth Ellis, Mike Evanoff and Mike George, after the four had pleaded guilty to charges of disorderly conduct following their arrest at Ilog Inn. The cases of P. H. Audistad, arrested at Taxicab Inn by federal agents exclusively, and of Ilog are yet to be disposed of.
