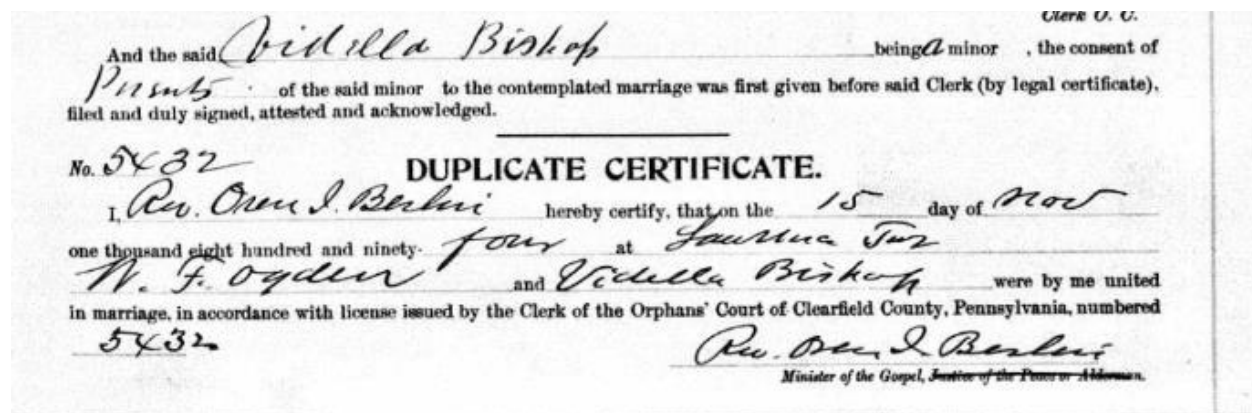

Theophile's Find A Grave record indicate the couple had 3 children. – In the 1930 census for Fairfield, Spokane WA, conducted 8 Apr 1930, Theophile Brown, 34 IL, age 30 at his 1st marriage, was a farmer, general farming. His parents were born in France. In the household were his wife Elsie G. (24 PA, father b. US, mother b. PA, age 20 at 1st marriage) & daughters Arlene D. (2 WA) & Lois M.
