





# Mark 30th Year For Company M

Thirty years ago this morning, Company M, Fourth Wisconsin Infantry, marched through Kenosha to the railway station and embarked on a trip from which many

never returned.

Company M was the first infantry unit to be furnished by Kenosha during the war, although a cavalry troop, later converted to an artillery battery under Capt. John S. Coney, had left previously. The company was recruited personally by its company commander, Captain Ed Dayton, after other recruiters had given up the attempt as impossible.

The company trained at Camp Douglas, Wisconsin, Camp Mac-Arthur, Texas, and Camp Merritt, New Jersey, before beginning its eighteen months of combat service at the front in France. In addition to Capt. Dayton, it was staffed by Lieutenants Asbury H. Vale and

Francis A. Singer.

Part of the company sailed to Europe on the liner Tuscania which was torpedoed and sunk en route. Cpl. Arthur Junker was lost in this action, one of Kenosha's first casualties.

# Rockford Claims First Recruiting Station Wedding

Miss Bessie Marshall of Henry, Ill., and Private Joseph Bizunowicz of Milwaukee, Wis., were the principals in what is said to have been the first wedding ceremony ever performed in a United States recruiting station. The marriage took place at the Rockford army recruiting station.

The ceremony was performed by Chaplain Rideout of the Eleventh field artillery of Camp Grant. Maj. J. H. Washburn and Army Field Clerk W. C. Barnum were the witnesses.

Buddies of the bridegroom, members of the Rockford recruiting detail, presented the couple with a chest of silver. The bridegroom was unable to obtain a furlough for a honeymoon.



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
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# Vernon Hills couple celebrates 75th wedding anniversary
