



Eight Criminal Cases Listed for Trial at January Term.

The January term of circuit court for Iron county will convene at the court house on Monday with Judge G. N. Risjord presiding. The first day of the term will be taken up hearing applications for citizenship papers, motions, etc. jurors have been summoned for the second day of the term. It is probable that the term will not extend longer than a week as the calendar of cases is not a long one. There are eight criminal cases scheduled for trial, two civil jury cases and five fact-court cases. In the fact-court cases, three are default divorce actions from other counties. 
