### Captain M. E. Bocher dies at Austin, Texas Was a citizen of Stephenville thirteen years

Captain M. E. Bocher died at Austin on February 14, and was buried at Sunlight, Stephens County on February 16, beside his wife.

Deceased had been in ill health for several months, and went to Austin accompanied by his daughter, Gracie, where he sought relief from the malady that was sapping his life, but nothing could be done.

Deceased was a native of Virginia, and was fifty-six years old. He located in Stephens County thirty years ago, where he owned fine ranch property at the time of his death.

Thirteen years ago he moved to Stephenville and purchased several tracts of city property. His object in moving to Stephenville was to give his children good school advantages.

About two years ago, accompanied by Miss Gracie, his daughter, he visited his old Virginia home, and a number of the great cities on the Atlantic Seaboard. The trip was made specially to give his daughter opportunity to see something of the great outside world.

Deceased was a man of great energy and endurance and a hard worker. When a task was undertaken he never faltered until the task had been finished. In habits he was careful, and frugal in the management of his business affairs, which resulted in his being able to accumulate a sufficiency of this world's goods for the proper maintenance of his family.

Pat was residing in Ballarat, Australia, in Feb 1913 when his father Nathan died. During his time in Australia, he is mentioned as working with the Southern Pacific Insurance Co. He has ads for “Pat Booher, real Estate and Insurance, 2 Grenville-street, South Ballarat.” He was stationed in Melbourne, Australia, in WWII, serving for 16 months until receiving a medical discharge.

His family history indicated that Pat lived in Australia until 1963 when he moved to Kentucky. His wife Sadie & children apparently stayed behind in Australia.
