



Anxiety Grips Nation Awaiting Death List

Washington, Without Advices on Tuscania, Unable to Still, Worry.

Washington, Feb. 8.—Hundreds of American homes are waiting anxiously for the names of nearly 150 fighting boys lost on the torpedoed Tuscama.

British and American wireless stations were searching the remotest points in Ireland and Scotland in the hope of locating further survivors from the ill-fated ship.

No attempt has been made by the War department to preserve a list of the lost or missing. Only the names of a few survivors have been received and indications today were that names of survivors would continue to come in slowly as they are assembled in Ireland by representatives of the War, State and Navy departments.

Three From Thief River Falls.

Thief River Falls, Minn., Feb. 9.— George Berden, Omar Anderson and Henry Rogers of Thief River Falls are believed to have been on the Tuscania. A letter from Borden received by his father here, written two days before the boat sailed, told of the departure of D company, Sixth battalion, 20th engineers, while a letter from Andersen was written on board ship.


of the bride's party.



A graveside service for Lula Borden Fox Arnold, 81, of Albany, will be conducted at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the Providence Cemetery. The Revs. Meredith Groves and Cris Torp will officiate.

Viewing hours will be until 8 tonight and from 9 a.m. to noon Wednesday at Fisher Funeral Home.

Mrs. Arnold died Feb. 17 at her home. Memorials can be made to the United Methodist Church Memorial Fund and left at the funeral home, Third Avenue and Washington Street.

She was born Aug. 10, 1903, in Bertha, Minn., and moved to Tangent in 1920 where she worked on her father's poultry farm known as Oakwood Poultry Farm.

She married Lowell Grant Fox on Aug. 10, 1927. They lived in the valley and at Nehalem until his death March 19, 1946.

Following his death Mrs. Arnold lived at Scio and Lebanon. She married Benton Ira Arnold on Sept. 27, 1950. He died Dec. 11, 1972. She moved to Albany in 1979.

Mrs. Arnold was a member of the Albany United Methodist Church, a past seventh degree member of the National Grange, and had attended the Baptist churches in Scio and Lebanon for many years.

"Albany (OR) Democrat-Herald" 14 Oct 1938 p 2 – Mr. & Mrs. H.B. Borden of Tangent celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. They were married 4 Oct 1888 in Hessel MI, where they lived for 2 years after their marriage. They then moved to Todd Co. MN, living there until 1911. Then they moved to Thief River Falls MN (says "also in Missouri"). In 1920 they moved to the West Coast, first to WA, living there 1 year before moving to OR in Oct 1921, to their present property near Tangent. During their marriage, they have operated a hatchery. This is the first family reunion since 1915; her sister (a bridesmaid) & his brother (the best man) attended. All 6 of their children were present: Watson Borden of Corvallis – George Borden, his wife & children (Evelyn & Grant) of Ridgefield WA – Myrtle Thorstad, her husband & son John of Thief River Falls MN – Jess Borden, his wife & son Herbert of Tangent OR – Pearl Simmons & husband of Riverside CA – Lula Fix, her husband & children (Helen, Larry & Lois) of Mohler.
