George E. Borden

George E. Borden of route 1, Ridgefield, died Monday morning at the Veteran's hospital in Portland after four weeks illness there. Mr. Borden was born 49 years ago in Minnesota. He was married in Colorado in June, 1919 and came to Clark county three years later. He has made his home in the Ridgefield district for 22 years and is a member of the American Legion post there.

He is survived by his wife, Annie Borden; one son, Grant and one daughter, Evelyn; all living at the family home. His parents are Mr. and Mrs. Herbert Borden of Tangent, Ore. There are three sisters: Mrs. Myrtle Simmons, Riverside, Calif; Mrs. Lula Fox of Moller, Ore.; Mrs. Myrtle Thorstad of Minnesota and two brothers, Watson Borden of Tangent and Jesse Borden of Corvallis, Ore.

Funeral services will be Wednesday at 2 o'clock at the Nazarene church in Ridgefield, the Rev. W. H. Lowry officiating. Vault entombment will be in the Ridgefield cemetery. The body will lie in state at Limber's chapel until just before the funeral services Wednesday.

Anxiety Grips Nation Awaiting Death List

Washington, Without Advices
on Tuscania, Unable to
Still Worry.

Washington, Feb. 8.—Hundreds of American homes are waiting anxiously for the names of nearly 150 fighting boys lost on the torpedoed Tuscania.

British and American wireless stations were searching the remotest points in Ireland and Scotland in the hope of locating further survivors from the ill-fated ship.

No attempt has been made by the War department to prepare a list of the lost or missing. Only the names of a few survivors have been received and indications today were that names of survivors would continue to come in slowly as they are assembled in Ireland by representatives of the War, State and Navy departments.

Three From Thief River Falls.

Thief River Falls, Minn., Feb. 9.—George Borden, Omar Anderson and Henry Rogers of Thief River Falls are believed to have been on the Tuscania. A letter from Borden received by his father here, written two days before the boat sailed, told of the departure of D company, Sixth Battalion, 20th engineers, while a letter from Anderson was written on board ship.

Five from Superior, One from Duluth.

Superior, Wis., Feb. 9.—H. C. Bird received a cablegram last night from his son Hershel Bird, who was on the Tuscania, saying he was rescued and is in Ireland. Five young men from Superior and one from Duluth were on the transport.

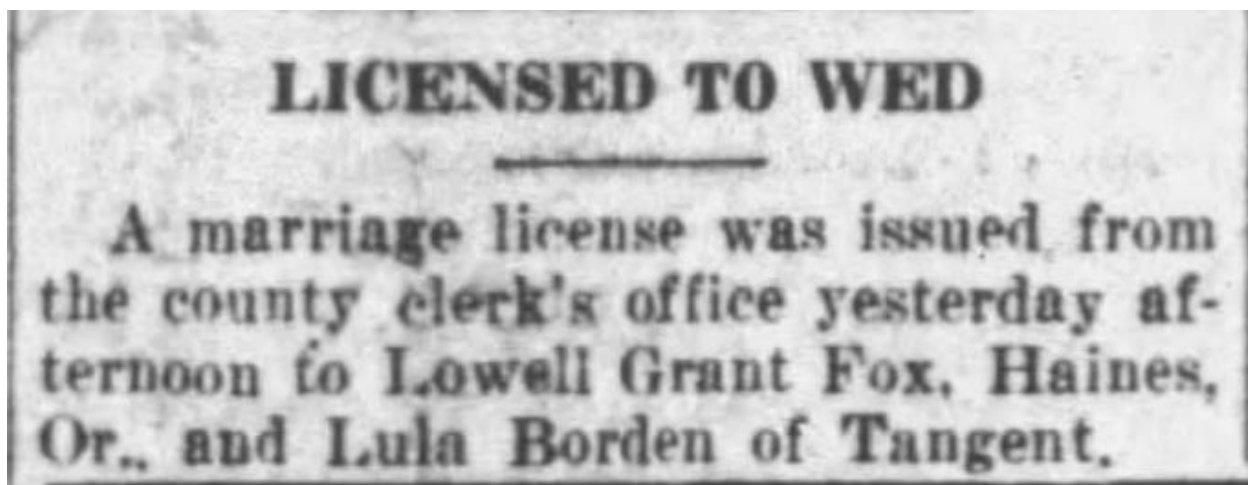

“Albany (OR) Democrat-Herald” 14 Oct 1938 p 2 – Mr. & Mrs. H.B. Borden of Tangent celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. They were married 4 Oct 1888 in Hessel MI, where they lived for 2 years after their marriage. They then moved to Todd Co. MN, living there until 1911. Then they moved to Thief River Falls MN (says “also in Missouri”). In 1920 they moved to the West Coast, first to WA, living there 1 year before moving to OR in Oct 1921, to their present property near Tangent. During their marriage, they have operated a hatchery. This is the first family reunion since 1915; her sister (a bridesmaid) & his brother (the best man) attended. All 6 of their children were present: Watson Borden of Corvallis – George Borden, his wife & children (Evelyn & Grant) of Ridgefield WA – Myrtle Thorstad, her husband & son John of Thief River Falls MN – Jess Borden, his wife & son Herbert of Tangent OR – Pearl Simmons & husband of Riverside CA – Lula Fix, her husband & children (Helen, Larry & Lois) of Mohler.
