Letters from their son, Luther Thomas Ball, who is in France with the Amreican forces, have been received by Mr. and Mrs. W. T. Ball of Riverside. According to recent casualty reports, Ball was among those severely wounded in action. He was on the ill-fated Tuscania which was sunk by a German submarine and for a while was believed to have been among the lost.

He is the grandson of John Ball of Cleburne.





\$9,850 Damage Suit Filed in Fatal Traffic Accident

Mrs. Zora Ball and Luther T. Ball. widow and son of William Thomas Ball. 73. who was killed on East Belknap Street May 24 in an automobile-pedestrian accident, Wednesday filed suit for \$9.850 damages in Ninety-sixth District Court against Sam Eckstine, owner of the truck which struck Mr. Ball.

In their petition it was set out that the son, 44, is physically unable to work. Jim Newberry allegedly was driving one of Eckstine's gasoline trucks when the accident occurred, the victim dying two days later, a few weeks before he would have observed his fiftieth wedding anniversary.
