## Arthur L. Bragg, 54, Dies Suddenly At Seavey Hop Yard

Arthur L. Bragg of Eugene, route 2, died suddenly at the Seavey hopyard Tuesday evening. A veteran of World War I, he was 54 years old.

He is survived by his wife, Goldie M. Bragg; one son, Wesley L., of Long Beach; one grandson; three step-brothers, Levi R. Carpenter, San Diego; Charles Lester, Eugene; Kenneth Carpenter, Los Angeles; his father, George Bragg, Creswell; one brother, Walter Bragg, Creswell; two sisters, Mrs. May Main, Creswell, and Mrs. Hazel Martin, Booth, Ore.

Services will be held Friday, Sept. 25, at the Veatch-Hollingsworth chapel at 2 o'clock. Interment will be in the IOOF cemetery number 2.

Arthur LeRoy Bragg was the son of George Bragg and Clara Lettie (Ellis) Bragg.

His World War I draft registration indicates a birthdate of 7 December 1888. All other records located indicate a birthdate of 7 December 1887 - with the 1900 census listing December 1887 while his Minnesota birth record, World War II draft registration and the U.S. Veterans Administration Master Index indicate 7 December 1887. His Minnesota birth record reports he was born in St. Lawrence township, Scott County, Minnesota, while his World War I draft registration lists Fergus Falls, Minnesota, and his World War II registration lists Clarisa, Minnesota.

Arthur was the oldest of four children. His siblings were:

Walter Logan Bragg, 1892 MN – 1965 OR

Clara Mae Bragg Main, 1895 MN – 1987 OR, Find A Grave 187147634

Hazel Delia Bragg Martin Ross, 1899 MN – 1988 OR. Find A Grave 53269922

In 1900, the family lived in Woodside, Otter Tail County, Minnesota, where George was a farmer. In 1910, the family lived in Malheur, Malheur County, Oregon.

When Arthur registered for the World War I draft on 5 June 1917, he gave a birthdate of 7 December 1888 in Fergus Falls, Minnesota. He was a self-employed chauffeur, residing in Klamath Falls, Oregon. Arthur entered the U.S. Army on 8 December 1917. As a private in the 20<sup>th</sup> Engineers, Company E, he sailed aboard the troopship SS “Tuscania” on 24 January 1918 from New York City.

The “Tuscania” was torpedoed and sunk on 5 February 1918 in the North Channel between Scotland and Ireland by German submarine UB-77, with the loss of 215 soldiers. In May 1919, Private Bragg, in the same unit, returned from war aboard “Santa Paula.” His military serial number was 250476. When he sailed on “Tuscania”, he listed his mother, Mrs. George Bragg, of Huntington, Oregon, as his next-of-kin. On his return voyage, she was listed as Mrs. Clara Bragg of Blodgett, Oregon.

In 1920, Arthur was the only child in the family living with his parents. They resided in Richardson, Lane County, Oregon, where Arthur was a laborer in a lumber mill.

On 11 June 1921, Arthur Bragg married Goldie Gibbs Carpenter in Lane County, Oregon. Goldie/Goldie Gibbs was the daughter of Franklin M. Gibbs and Ettie (Baty) Gibbs. Goldie Gibbs was born 4 August 1896 in Poplar Bluff, Butler County, Missouri. She had married John Martin Carpenter in Randolph County, Arkansas, on 23 Oct 1909. John Martin Carpenter (1886 Missouri – 1940 California) has Find A Grave record. 30900779. They divorced in February 1921.

John and Goldie Carpenter had three sons:

Raymond Levi Carpenter (1911 MO – 1978 CA), Find A Grave 269233373

Lester Charles/Charles Lester Carpenter (1913 NM – 1955 OR), Find A Grave 187124998

Kenneth M. Carpenter (1915 OR – 1968 CA), Find A Grave 144885702

Arthur and Goldie Bragg’s son, Wesley Logan Bragg, was born 11 July 1923 in Oregon and died 4 November 1946 in California, Find A Grave 75396252.

In 1930, Arthur and Goldie Bragg, with 6-year-old son Wesley Bragg and Arthur’s stepsons Levi R., Charles L. and Kenneth [sic] M. live in Eugene, Lane County, Oregon, where Arthur is a janitor in a bakery and Goldie works in a laundry.

In 1940, Arthur, Goldie and Wesley live in Eugene, Lane County, Oregon. Arthur is “unable to work” and Goldie works in a laundry.

Arthur died in the Seavey Hop Yard from a coronary occlusion.

Following Arthur’s death, Goldie M. Bragg married Leo Ross John on 5 January 1945 in California. Leo was born 13 March 1907 in Bloomfield, Davis County, Iowa, and died 9 July 1991 in Los Angeles County, California. He was the son of Manford Lynch John (Find A Grave 48977765) and Mary Catherine (Day) John (Find a Grave 48977622).

Goldie Mae John died 15 April 1975 in Los Angeles County, California. According to her obituary, published in the “Northeast Star-Review” (Los Angeles CA) of Thursday, 24 April 1975, page 3, she is buried in Rose Hills Memorial Park, Whittier, Los Angeles County, California.

Bragg, who will enlist in the forestry service.

Quite a demonstration was made at the depot when the train left today. A large crowd of friends were on hand to bid the boys farewell. The train delayed departure for about thirty minutes on this account.

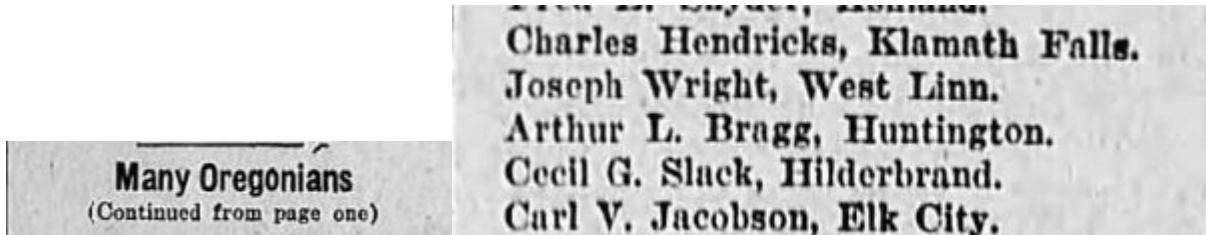
## FOURTEEN GO TO SERVICE

for Enlistment.**

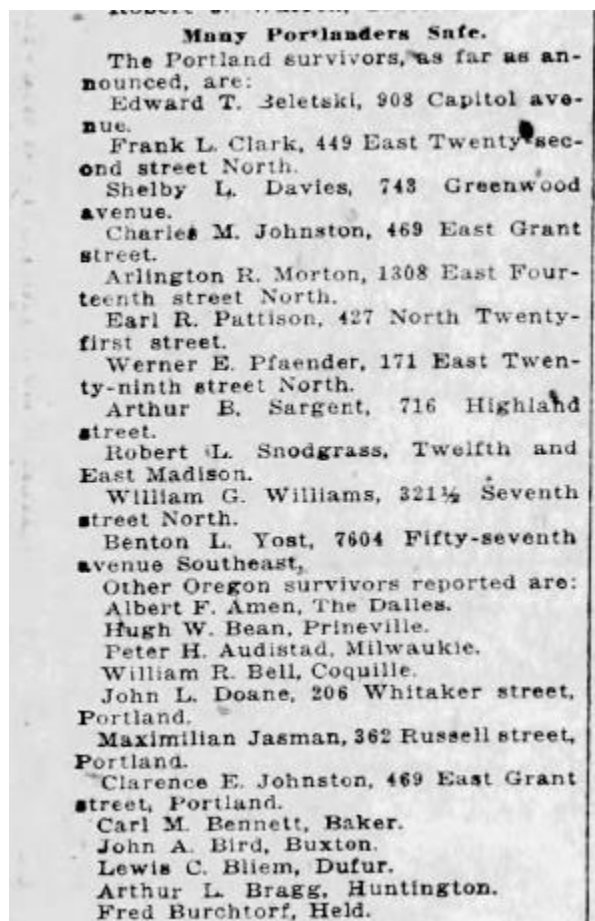

## OREGON BOYS WITH 20TH ENGINEERS LAND

**MEN HURRIEDLY TRANSFERRED  
TO CAMP MERRITT.**

**Numerous Towns of State Represented by Regiment Which Served in Many Parts of France.**

NEW YORK, May 28.—(Special.)—Some of the small Oregon towns not represented before among the returning troops were in evidence today when the 20th engineers arrived early on the Santa Paula. There are Oregonians in almost every company and from almost every part of the state.

The transport docked at 7 o'clock this morning and the rush of transfer from the boat to the piers and from the piers to ferry, and thence to Camp Merritt, was so hurried that these men of adventure had small time to recount their experiences. The men served in many parts of France.

# James Oxford danced way out of doghouse

James "Jim" Oxford's path to becoming an accomplished square dancer got off to an unlikely start. His wife forced him to do it.

"Jim was kind of in disfavor with me at the time, and I told him the only way out of the doghouse was to go folk dancing with me," Irene Oxford said in a phone interview.

She was reminiscing about her husband of 56 years who collapsed Wednesday, apparently of a heart attack, in their West Sacramento home. Mr. Oxford, 77, died a short time later in the emergency room at Sutter General Hospital.

The couple was living in Dunsmuir in the mid-'50s when Mr. Oxford was coaxed onto the dance floor, she recalled.

"Jim wasn't too keen on it, but he turned out to be an excellent dancer, he did," his wife said. "And it got him out of the doghouse, it sure did."

Their marriage went on to flourish, with Mr. Oxford working 37 years for the Southern Pacific railroad by day, then going out to dance three or four nights a week, she said.

"It was good exercise and we just loved it," she said. "It was something we could do together. It keeps you together."

Mr. Oxford's dancing skills eventually

improved to the point where he was teaching a square dance class Thursday nights for the Sacramento Parks and Recreation Department at Clunie Clubhouse, she said. He taught that class for two decades. He also was a square dance caller, and called at square dance festivals all over California.

Born and raised in Russellville, Ark., Mr. Oxford moved to San Diego in 1944, where he worked at a variety of jobs, including as an ice route driver and as a machinist in an aircraft plant.

On the ice route he met the former Irene Schroeder, a widow with two sons. She was five years his senior.

"I did rob the cradle," she recalled with a laugh, "but it worked out. My mother said, 'You'd better hang on to him.'"

They married Sept. 4, 1949, and moved to Dunsmuir, where her father, Henry Schroeder, who was chief clerk of the Shasta Division of SP, got his son-in-law a job with the railroad as an apprentice electrician, his wife said.

In 1959 Mr. Oxford transferred to SP's Sacramento shops, working first as an electrician, later as a computer programmer.

In addition to her two sons, the couple had a son of their own, who predeceased Mr. Oxford.

After Mr. Oxford retired from the railroad in 1986, the couple devoted even

In addition, Mr. Oxford served two terms as president of the Sacramento International Folk Dance & Arts Council.

"We had a wonderful life, we really did," his wife said. "We've been on some wonderful cruises, all over. Jim was a wonderful husband. He looked out for me."

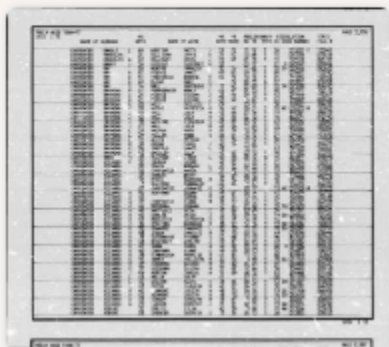

## Two Springfield Accidents Fatal

SPRINGFIELD, Ore. (AP)—Two men were killed in separate accidents near here last night and two others were hospitalized, one with serious injuries.

Charlie Lester Carpenter, 41, Springfield, was killed outright in a one-car accident on highway 126 10 miles east of here at about 9:45 p.m. He was a passenger in a late model car registered to Samuel L. Bassett, 30, whom Coroner Fred Buel said he believed was operating the car.

Bassett was in serious condition at McKenzie-Willamette Memorial hospital. Another passenger in the car, Willie Lee Cochran, 39, Sweet Home, suffered less serious injuries.

State police said the victim was thrown out of the car when it overturned several times in a roadside ditch. The car had to be pried up to recover the body.

Two other occupants of the car were taken to McKenzie-Williamette Hospital in Springfield by Eugene Ambulance. Ambulance attendants said the driver of the car, Samuel L. Basset, 30, of 6149 McKenzie Highway, had

also been thrown out of the car by the impact of the crash.

The other injured man, Willie Lee Cochran, 39, Sweet Home, was caught in the wrecked car.

Basset suffered concussion and possible skull fracture and remained in serious condition Friday morning. Cochran apparently suffered only minor injuries.

A highway patrolman who investigated the crash said the car had skidded sideways and rolled over several times in the ditch. He said it traveled 716 feet after leaving the highway.

Police were uncertain immediately after the crash who had been driving the vehicle. Basset, who was knocked unconscious in the accident, later regained consciousness in the hospital and said he had been the driver.

Carpenter's body was taken to the Bartholomew-Buell Chapel. He is survived by his widow and three children.

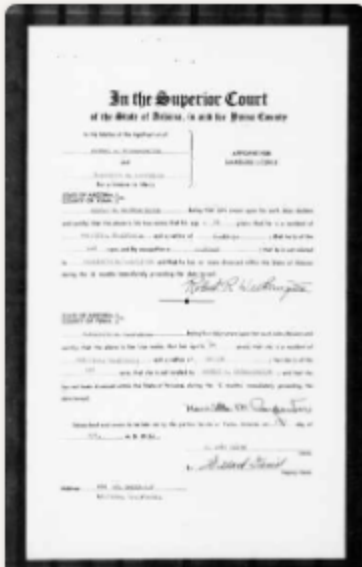

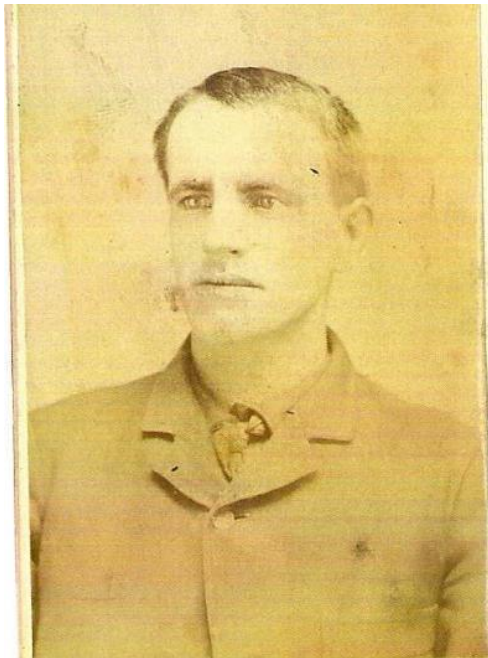

# When Jitney Balks Bridal Party Walks

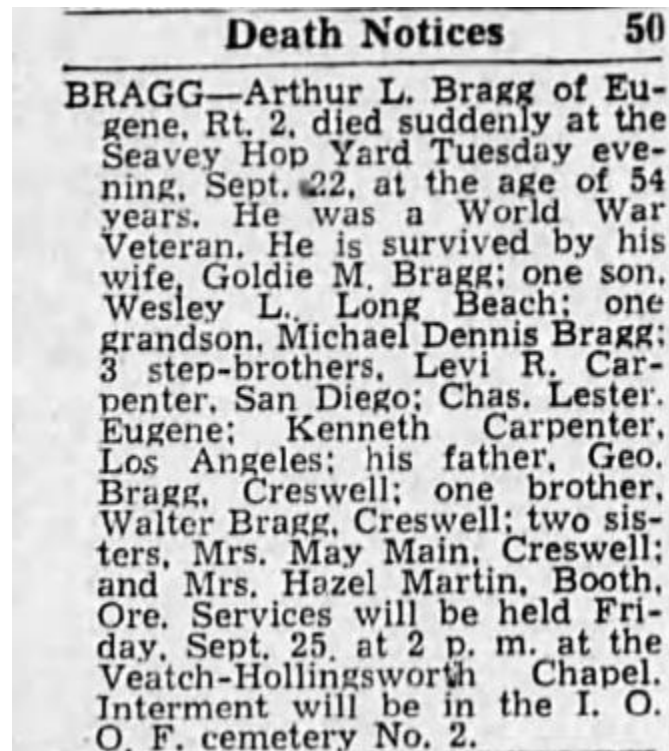
