



# SPRINGFIELD SEAMAN IN HURRICANE'S PATH AT CAMP IN VIRGINIA

Springfield, S. D., Sept. 29.—Seaman Don Balvin, son of Mr. and Mrs. Emil Balvin here, reports that he was at Little Creek, Va., last week in the direct path of the hurricane which swept the eastern seaboard and found it a harrowing experience.

The storm hit on Tuesday evening and washed one big ship up on the shore. The coast guard and navy rescued the crew and no lives were lost. Lights, telephone and radio were all put out of commission by the storm, some large buses were tipped over and many of the barracks at the naval base there were under water.

The young man is a signalman in the navy and the men were on duty for more than 24 hours without rest while the storm was on. He reports that he had never seen such wind and rain before.
