





## Lynch Got Sentence.

Mathew J. Lynch was arrested in Port Huron by Police Captain Collins on a charge of printing, publishing and distributing obscene literature manifestly tending to the corruption of the morals of youths. Lynch guilty in the circuit court before Judge Law who sentenced him to one year in House of Correction. Detroit Lynch never had any steady means of employment. After the Labor Leader, which he published for a time, became extinct, he interested himself in matters pertaining to labor organization. He later embarked in the printing business in the employ of C. E. Patterson and was engaged as a distributor and solicitor for the Standard Publishing Co. at the time of his arrest.

This is the man, who with another fellow named McPherson, a discharged employee of the Sanilac Sugar Reining Co., of Croswell, went around to the beet growers trying to negotiate with them for so-called claims against the Sugar Company which never materialized.

## Olivet families will rebuild

# 'Not the end of the world'

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### By HELEN CLEGG Staff Writer

OLIVET-He sat on a downed tree, calmly eating from a paper plate and sipping coffee. Beside him was a flatbed truck loaded with four diesel tractors — all on their sides.

Behind Norm Heddon, at 6457 Mc-Donald Rd., was a house that had fallen in, an upside down car and a trailer in pieces in the swamp. Yet seven people in his family survived Saturday's tornado — with little more than scratches, cuts and bruises. Two are hospitalized.

"This isn't the end of the world," he said. "We'll keep right on living. Without a doubt I'll rebuild right here. We've got the well and septic tank here; you have to go from what you have left. There won't be enough insurance but it will help."

Lying by the rubble apparently unhurt, Laddie was still guarding his heap of a home while several men worked with chain saws. A new tractor and the house roof and a fence were somewhat damaged.

"After seeing some people down the road, we are awful lucky," said Mrs. Shoemaker.

THAT SEEMED to be the attitude of most people Sunday. They would stand by their badly damaged houses or outbuildings and point down the road to someone else worse off.

Neola Bailey, 5115 Marshall Rd., and her husband, Lyman, ran Bailey's Foster Care Home for six aged men. When she tried to close the door, the wind threw her against something in the kitchen and broke her arm. The house is unlivable.

A deputy sheriff living nearby took her and one injured man to the Charlotte hospital; the rest were transferred to the Eaton County Medical Care Facility.
