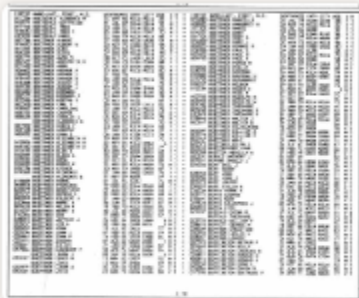

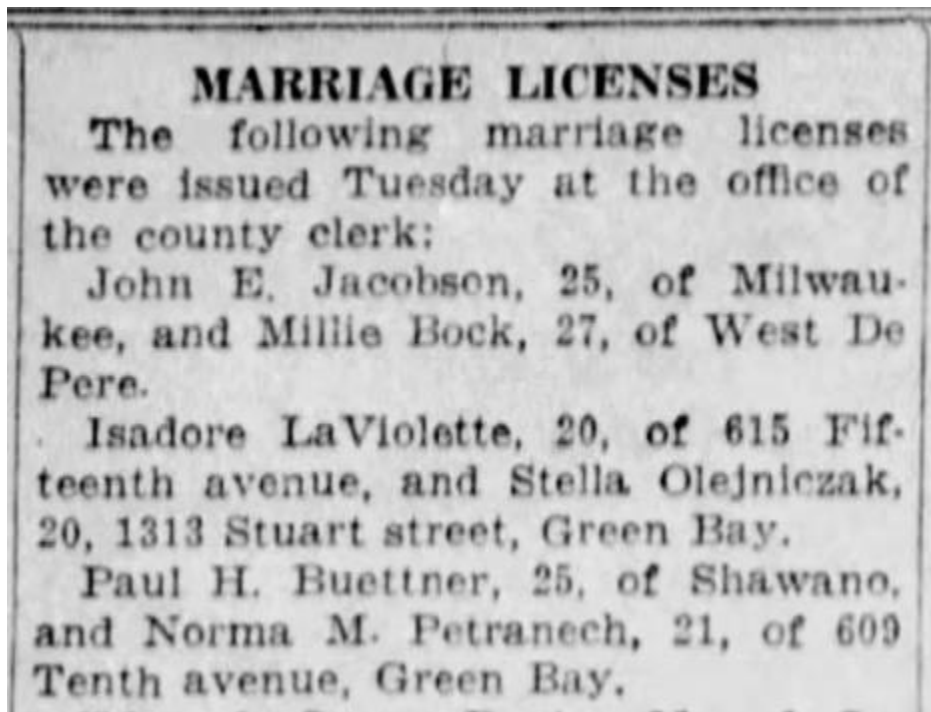

# Rites Set for Ralph Wescott

Prominent Shawano  
Figure Died Tuesday  
After Active Lifetime

Special to Press-Gazette  
SHAWANO, Wis. — Funeral services for Ralph R. Wescott, 57, member of a prominent pioneer Shawano family and a resident of the city for many years, will be held at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon in the chapel at Woodlawn cemetery. Mrs. Wescott died suddenly in the Shawano Municipal hospital at 7 o'clock Tuesday evening. The Rev. Donald Keuper will officiate at the services.

Known as "Chi," Mr. Wescott was born May 23, 1894, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Dayne Wescott. He was a retired army officer, holding the rank of major, and had served as a police captain and lawyer. He had been ill for several years and hospitalized the past three weeks.

The family had been making its home on the north beach of Shawano lake since returning to Shawano at the close of World War II.

## Grandson of Settler

Mr. Wescott also was the grandson of Charles Wescott, who in 1843 became the first white settler in Shawano.

He had a varied and colorful career. He enlisted in the army shortly after the United States entered World War I in 1917, joining Shawano's famed Company F. Before embarking to France, however, Ralph and three other members were transferred to a 32nd division truck company and were aboard the ill fated troop transport Tuscania, sunk by German torpedoes off the coast of Ireland in 1918.

Wescott and his three home town buddies, Dr. A. A. Cantwell, Paul Buettner and the late Ted Regling, survived the sinking and were landed in Northern Ireland by rescue boats.

At the close of the first war, Wescott applied for and won a commission in the reserve officers corps and was made a major in the quartermaster corps at the outbreak of World War II.

## Was District Attorney

After the first war, Wescott had served for several years as a police captain on the West Allis police force at State Fair park while studying law nights at Marquette university.

He returned to Shawano in 1920 to take over management of his father's insurance agency and to establish his law practice. He also finished out his father's term as city clerk and was elected district attorney of Shawano county in 1932.

1932.  
He served one term as Chef de Gare (commander) of the 40 et 8 and was a member of the local American Legion post. He also was highly active in civic and community affairs, a member of the Presbyterian church, past master of the Shawano lodge, F. and AM, and a member of the chapter of Royal Arch Masons, serving as high priest of the group for one year.

Surviving are Mrs. Wescott, the former Theresa Featherston, who married Mr. Wescott in 1920; one son, Dayne, now with the army at Ft. Riley, Kas.; a brother, Ward, Crandon; and four grandchildren. A daughter, Mrs. Sheldon Schmidt died in 1948.

The Schweers Funeral home in Shawano is in charge of arrangements. Burial will be in the Woodlawn cemetery.

## Sunday Drive Bang-Up Job For Man and His '60 Auto

STURGEON BAY (PG)— A Milwaukee man and his 1960 automobile had a bang-up time in Door County Sunday afternoon.

Paul H. Buettner, 63, was involved in two accidents in about two hours. The mishaps occurred about 17 miles from each other and the second sent the driver to Algoma Hospital with head cuts.

Buettner's car forced one driven by Mrs. Rojah Notz, 25, Sturgeon Bay, Rt. 1, off Highway 42-57 about a quarter mile from the city limits at 1:45. The woman's car went onto the shoulder of the road where it was hit by Buettner's car. Left sides of both cars were damaged. Buettner was traveling south and Mrs. Notz north. The Milwaukeean posted a \$16

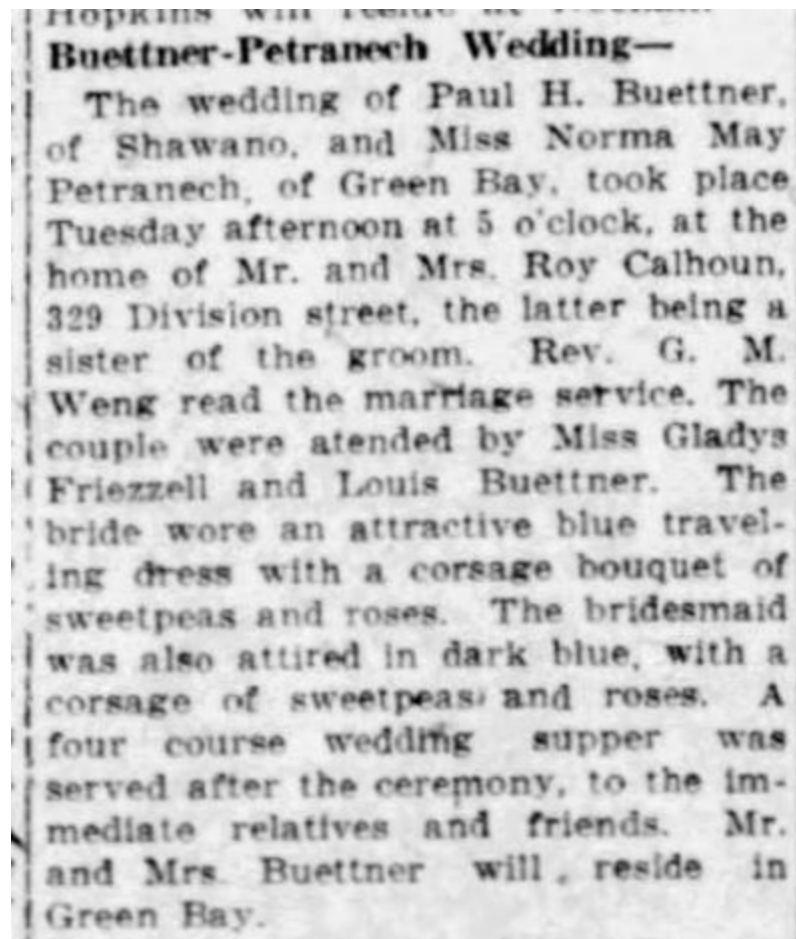
bond on a charge of operating his vehicle on the left side of the road.

At 3:48, Buettner went 480 feet on the edge of the road when attempting to round Fairland Curve near Brussels. He stopped when hitting a car parked near the Sinclair Service Station. The parked car, owned by Anthony J. Dier, 18, Brussels, was listed as a complete wreck and the right side of the Buettner car was damaged. Buettner was taken to the hospital by Door County police ambulance.

Buettner said he was blinded by the sun before going off the curve.

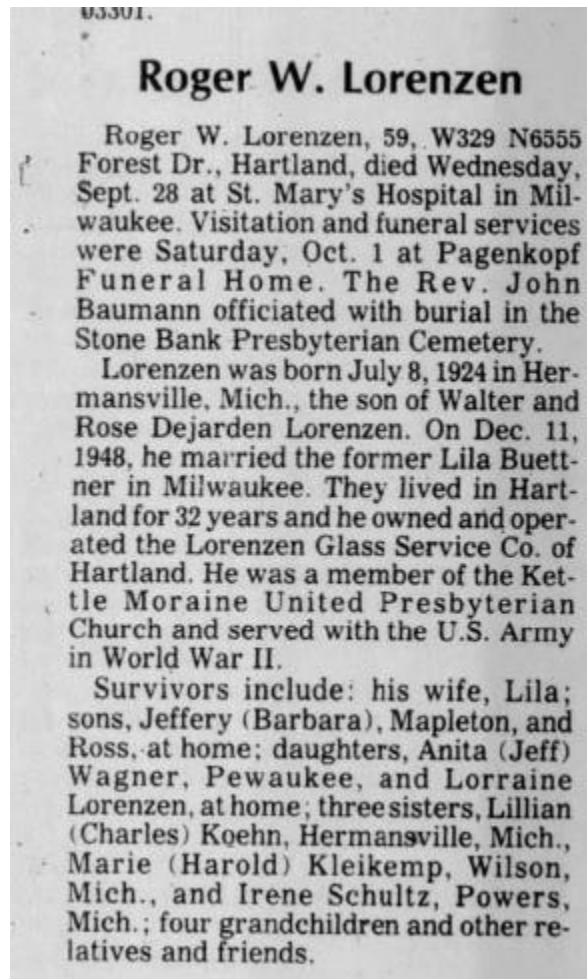

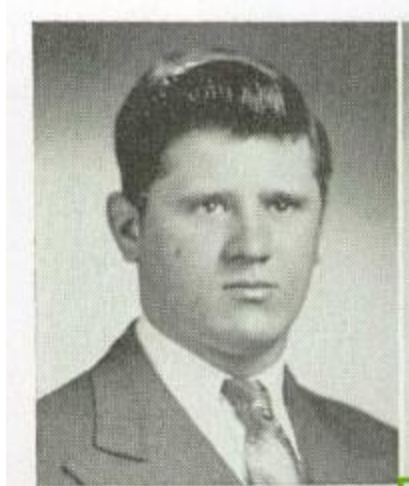

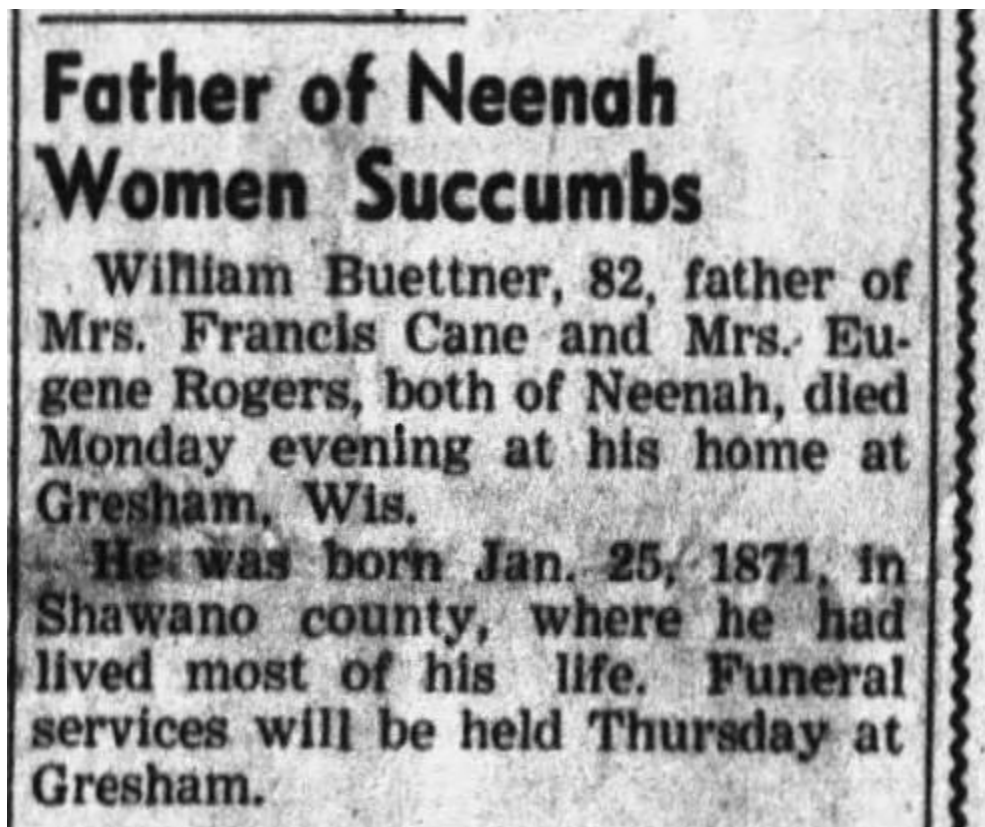

# RAISES TROUT FOR FISHERMEN

**Certain Cure For Failure in  
Whipping the Streams —  
No More Empty Creels**

TILLED A, Wis. — No longer need the modern Walton journey home with empty creel. There have sprung up in Wisconsin a number of "fish farms" whose mission is to eliminate any such piscatorial vacuum. Herman Buettner, proprietor of Rockyville Fish Hatchery, at Tilleda, just off Highway 29, one of the pioneers in fish farming, guarantees you all the trout that you may care to carry — at \$1 a pound. You catch the fish yourself, he weighs them, you pay him and there you are. If you don't catch any, there's no cost. But you will.

Five years ago Mr. Buettner decided there must be a better way

of keeping body and soul together than in wresting a living from the rocky soils of Shawano county. In casting about, as it were, for an idea, he heard that our trout streams were rapidly being depopulated by the energetic lashings given them by local and visiting anglers. This being the case, he reasoned, why not establish a preserve of your own and stock it to such extent that there would always be fish for the fishermen? This he did.

The Buettner hatchery now consists of a small building wherein the eggs are hatched and the fry kept until they can be released into the first pool. Another pool contains thousands of fingerlings, another trout up to seven inches and the largest pool contains several hundred two and three-pound trout that are used for spawning purposes.

There are also four fishing ponds that are well stocked with big trout of all species. It is from these that Mr. Buettner's revenue is derived. The angler merely or drops his worm and gets his fish.

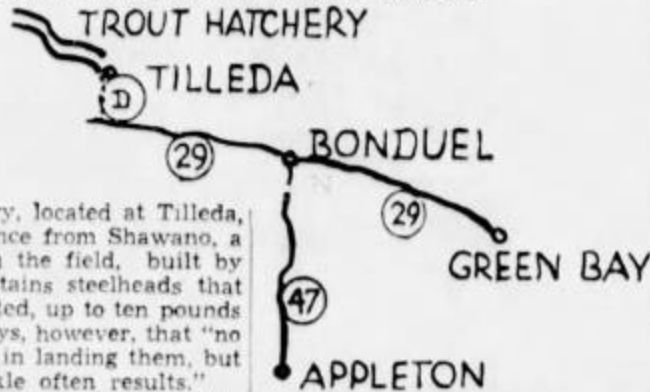

trout hatchery, located at Tilleda, a short distance from Shawano, a small lake in the field, built by Herman, contains steelheads that weigh, as stated, up to ten pounds apiece. He says, however, that "no one succeeds in landing them, but smashed tackle often results."

Fishing in this pond is permitted and a charge of one dollar per pound is made by the owner for any trout caught. He can sell them, too, for he owns the place and raises the fish just as any farmer does poultry or anything else.

Whether or not you care to try for one of these monsters a trip to this magnificent hatchery will be worth your time. Herman has about 30 rearing ponds in which, at the time of my last visit there, on October 1, he had approximately 600,000 trout varying in size

Anyone interested in trout propagation on a large scale will do well to visit Herman Buettner's place. It is a most interesting and instructive sight. A thrill cannot help but follow seeing those big, lusty fellows churn the water when a handful of food is thrown into the pond. At this time of the year the scenery all about is beautiful. Concrete roads take you there. It's a grand setting for a Sunday trip. Drive up there and marvel at this unbelievable work of one man.
