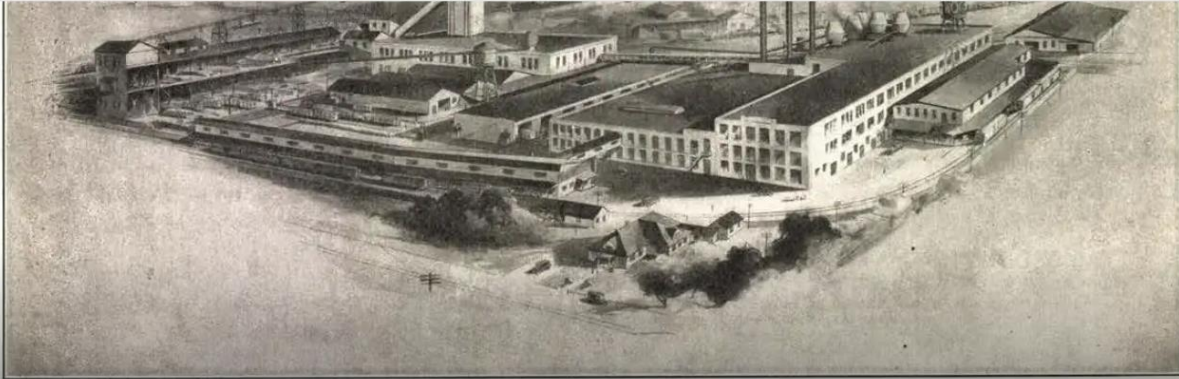

Names of 30 survivors landed at Islay also were forwarded.

The 600 are believed a part of the 1,100 reported landed at Duncrana and Larne, in last night's war department dispatches.

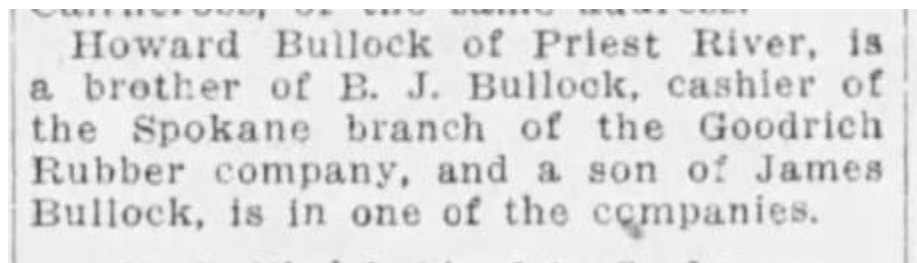

W. W. COOPER BELIEVED ON TROOP VESSEL

**Father of Well Known Tacoma
man Unable to Learn Whether
Son Was Saved.**

**FATE OF CAMP LEWIS
SOLDIERS NOT KNOWN**

**Three Washington Boys Re-
ported Safe—Stadium Teach-
er Certain His Brother
Was on Liner.**

With the fate of about 60 Camp Lewis and Tacoma men believed to be aboard the Tuscania still unknown the first ray of hope for Washingtonians came last night in a dispatch from Washington, D. C., that Private Ralph Uphus of Enumclaw, company F, 6th battalion, 20th engineers, was numbered among the survivors. Corporal Howard E. Bullock of Newport, Wash., and Private Henry B. Peterson of Elk, Wash., also were saved.

It seemed certain last night that William W. "Bill" Cooper, well known Tacoma teacher and golfer and a member of company F, 20th engineers, was on the ill-fated liner. A. J. Bell, on the faculty at the Stadium high school, said last night he was positive his brother, Corporal Joseph Bell, and a member of the same regiment, was on the liner.

Names of 24 Tacoma men and 33 from Camp Lewis, known to be members of the engineering unit, were available last night but it was not definitely established that all of these men were aboard the liner and nothing had been heard concerning any of them.

News Sounds Good to Father.

A. J. Uphus, father of Ralph Uphus, was overjoyed last night when informed by The Ledger that his son was among the survivors.

"Well, that sounds pretty good to me," he said. "We were positive Ralph was on the Tuscania. We received a card from him a few days ago saying he was about to sail for France. He only enlisted in December in Seattle and certainly got started cross in a hurry."

"Ralph is a Washington boy, born in Everett. He is only 22, but he was superintendent of the A. N. U. mill here and making good as a lumberman. That's why he enlisted in the forestry unit."

William W. Cooper taught at the Central school six years and was winner of the local city golf tournament last summer. His father, Frank B. Cooper, superintendent of Seattle schools, said over the long distance telephone late last night that it was practically certain he was on the Tuscania.

"I wired Congressman John F. Miller of Seattle," said Mr. Cooper, "but cannot learn whether my boy was rescued. He enlisted in the 20th engineers in Seattle last November and just a few days ago I had a letter from him stating that he would be going overseas shortly."

Cooper Champion Golfer.

Cooper, who is 26 years old, is well known here through his prowess at golf. Up to the time of his enlistment he was the star golfer of the Meadow Park club. In 1916 he won the Meadow Park club championship and made a good showing in the city meet. Last summer he topped off a successful season on the links, by capturing the Tacoma championship, defeating Herbert S. Griggs, Country club star, in the final 36-hole championship.

Cooper taught the manual training department at the Central school up until his enlistment in November.

Corp. Joseph Bell, a member of the 20th engineers and said to have been on the Tuscania, is a brother of A. J. Bell of Stadium High school faculty. Bell said last night that his brother, who is 25 years old, was a junior at the Michigan School of Mines, and enlisted from there in the Michigan engineers, which were later transferred. Bell heard from his brother a few weeks ago and is reasonably sure that his brother was to have left on the Tuscania.

No Word About Root.

George S. Long yesterday received a telegram from his brother, Maj. James E. Long, that George S. Long, jr., was not on the Tuscania, but was believed to be in France. Nothing has been learned concerning H. G. Root, Tacoma boy known to be on the transport with the 100th aero squadron.

Thirty-three soldiers who left Camp Lewis several weeks ago to join the 20th engineers and who are believed to have been on the troopship Tuscania when she was torpedoed, including 30 loggers and mill men largely from the deport brigade. The men went east under the command of Col. M. E. Saville, who reported for duty at Camp Lewis yesterday. The names of all the men known to have left camp in time to join the 20th engineers before the Tuscania sailed follow:

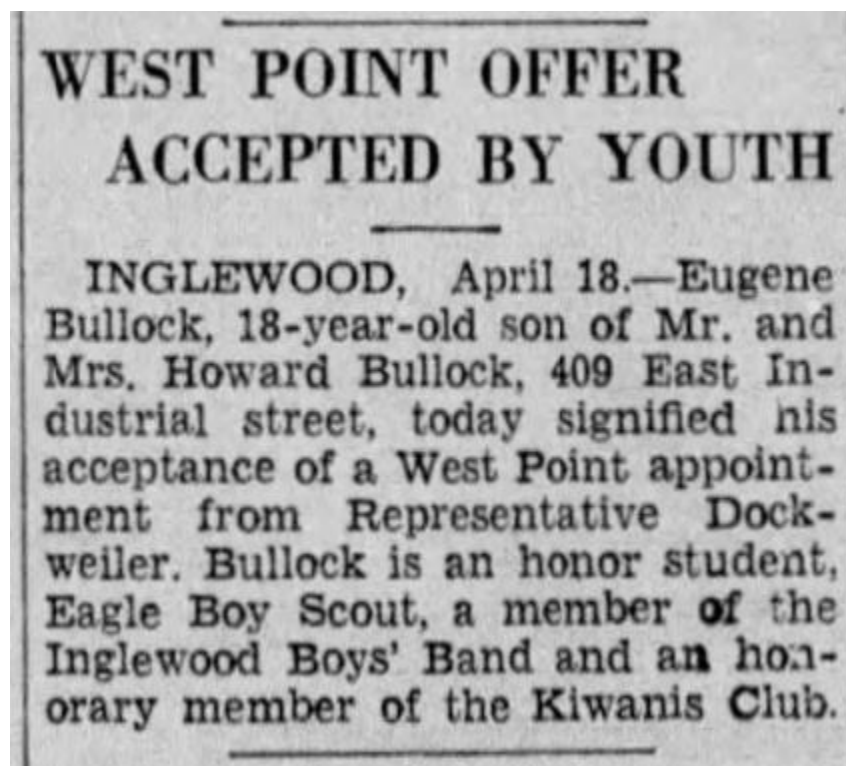

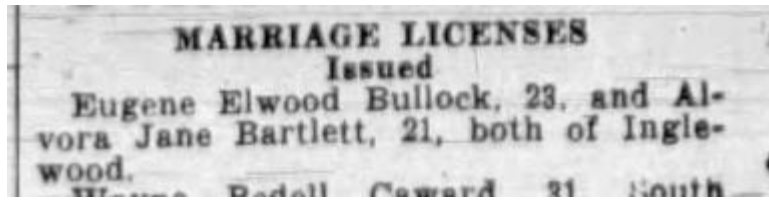

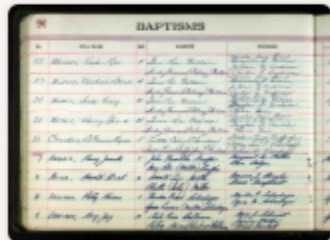
