

Triple Murderer's Trial Begun After Three Days Delay

Mifflin Demands Chair

Jury Is Selected and Draper Murder Trial Is Begun at Idabel

One of the most important murder trials ever to be held in this section was begun at Idabel, Monday before Judge Arnett, when Charles Draper, alleged confessed slayer of three men, was arrainged for trial.

Draper is alleged to have confessed slaying E. S. Chappel, of Springdale, Ark., Eugene Harris of Antlers and Jack O'Dell, of Ultima Thule. The bodies were found more than a week after the murders and Draper was connected with the crime when he was reported to have been seen with the truck belonging to Chappel. Draper was apprehended at Clarksville, Texas and admitted to the murder of the three He was brought to the McCurtain county jail at Idabel

liminary hearing, after first indicating that he would throw himself on the mercy of the court.

The trial was delayed three days in the selection of a jury s and 160 special veniremen in ade dition to the 58 regular jurors were summoned before twelve men could be found who could qualify. The jury composed of L. W. Lunsford, Cerro Gordo; R. W. May, Pollard; Arthur Hill Haworth; Silas Bumpass and J. L. Gipson, Rufe; R. J. Carpenter, Ringold; F. H. Hendrix, C. M. Coleman and Otho Lites, of Wright City; J. A. Baggs, Battiest and R. D. Lackey of Bethel was finally chosen.



Silas J. Bumpass, who has been living in Bryan county during the past five years has moved back to this county, locating on a farm of Berry Roan in the Oleta neighborhood.

Bumpass, it will be recalled, was one of the county boys who was a member of the A. E. F. in the World War No. 1, although he had a hard time getting across the pond, as the boat on which he was making the trip was torpedoes, and he was rescued several days later as he floated around on a life-saver.



Rest of the Story After 67 Years

The year was 1926.

It was an event that would be featured 50 years later in the hometown paper, but as Paul Harvey says, that wasn't "the rest of the story."

A young man worked at a sawmill at Rufe and was waiting for Uncle John O'Bannon to bring Beulah to the sawmill that Friday.

They would walk about a mile to Bro. Bert Bumpass' home. There they would be married.

Beulah arrived, her biggest fear being Ance's failure to obtain a marriage license as he had promised.

Things went well. He had the license and hand-in-hand they strolled up the sandy lane toward the preacher's home.

A knock on the door brought Mrs. Bumpass to answer, informing the young couple that Brother Bert was very ill with the flu. He couldn't even get out of bed.

Upon hearing the conversation, Bro. Bumpass summoned his wife and young daughter, instructing them to bring all the pillows and prop him up in bed. He would, indeed, perform the ceremony, dressed in his longhandles and his brow dripping with a fevered sweat.

They lost track of each other, that compassionate Baptist preacher and the young couple. But all remembered the event.

Sixty-seven years passed.

Last week, a graying lady walked into the Times office for a subscription to the paper. "Bumpass?" she was asked.
"That's an unusual name," the man said.

"Did you ever know a Bumpass who was a Baptist preacher who lived at Rufe?"

"Bert Bumpass," she replied, "He was my husband Carl's father."

"Did he ever talk about marrying a young couple while sick in bed?"

"Oh, yes, I even have a newspaper clipping which tells about it."

"Whatever happened to Bro. Bumpass?"

"They moved from Rufe to Red River Bottom, then northeast of Soper and finally to Hugo. He is buried here at Mt. Olivet Cemetery."

"Why do you ask?" Mrs. Carl Bumpass said gently.

"That couple was Ance and Beulah Honeywell," said the editor. "My father and mother."

"Either still alive?"

"My mom."

"Tell her to come visit us."

"I will."

Choctaw County rancher Carl Bumpass, by the way, was a oneyear-old witness to that wedding. --- By Jim Honeywell


