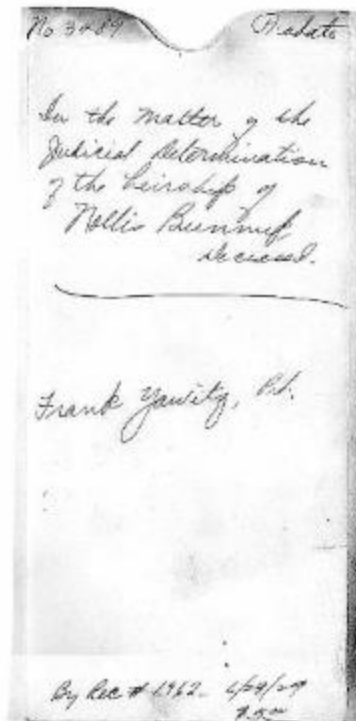



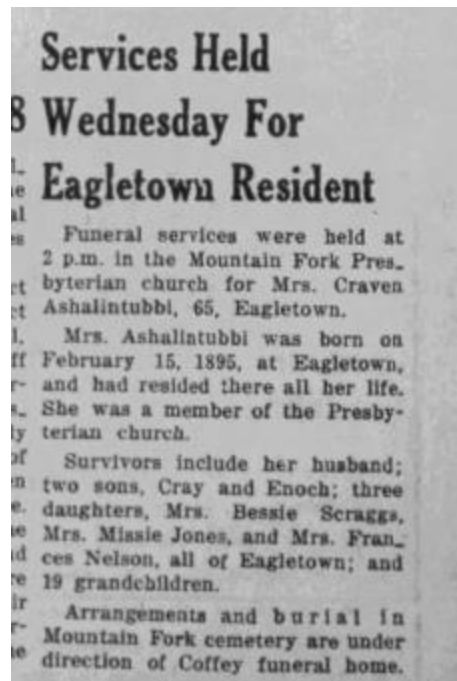

AR. - Find A Grave record indicates she had a brother Nollis (WWI veteran), brother William (who married Pikey), brother Farlis & sister Sillin [but this appears incorrect, as only Farlis & Nollis are on the Choctaw rolls. Sillin was her mother & William, then married to Pikey, was her father]. – Cause of death on her AR death



record: “probably carcinoma of pancreas.” - Buried in Mountain Fork Cemetery, Eagletown, McCurtain OK. F: 47470909.

#### Notes:

In 1904 Nollis was removed from Choctaw tribal rolls as someone said he was dead & his brother Farlis was alive – when the opposite was true, Farlis having died in 1900.

In 1906 a decision was made that his brother Farlis had died 19 Feb 1900 (Choctaw roll by blood #2257) but Nollis was alive (Choctaw roll by blood #2255). Choctaw Roll Card 863 in 1896 listed him as “Morris Bunnup.”

Dawes Final Rolls, Choctaw by blood, Card 863 (copied above) – Eagletown, Eagle County, Indian Territory

William, age 34, full Choctaw, enrolled 1896 Eagle, daughter of Joe & Wisey (both parents deceased)

Sillin, his wife, age 28, deceased, daughter of John & Melvina Stephens

Nollis, his son, age 5 deceased – note that he was listed as Morris in 1896. Note added on record that he had died 19 Feb 1900, proof of death was filed 15 Dec 1902 & his enrollment was cancelled by the Department 8 Jul 1904. Found to be living on 25 Sep 1902 & restored to roll under Department authorization of 6 Nov 1906.

Wisey, his daughter, age 4

Farlis, his son, age 1, deceased. Died 19 Feb 1900 & his enrollment as Choctaw cancelled by the Department 6 Nov 1904. A handwritten note on his line reads: “April 25/99” – and this could likely be his birth date – 25 Apr 1899.

“McCurtain Gazette” (Idabel OK) 8 Nov 1916 p 3 – Nollis Bunnup of Eagletown was in Idabel OK on Monday & could not do without the “Gazette” so he subscribed for a year

“Tulsa (OK) Daily Legal News” 24 Sep 1919 p 4 – Nollis Bunnup, Choctaw Roll 2255, of Eagletown, oil & gas lease to Harry Goldfeder Hugo on his property – Department notified, restricted lands

“Tulsa (OK) Daily Legal News” 17 Oct 1919 p 4 – Nollis Bunnup, Choctaw Roll 2255, of Eagletown, item 40734, oil & gas lease filed Muskogee OK, US Indian Agency

“Tulsa (OK) Daily Legal News” 8 Jan 1920 p 4 – Nollis Bunnup, Choctaw Roll 2255, lease approved 17 Dec 1919, item 40734

“Tulsa (OK) Daily Legal News” 18 Jun 1924 p 3 – Matter 48986, Nollis Bunnup of Eagletown (Choctaw Roll 2255) sold property to J.K. Wells of Oklahoma City. Just ahead of this entry is the notation that Wisey Bunnup, now Ashalintubbi, Chippewa Roll 2256, also sold property to J.K. Wells.

“Tulsa (OK) Daily Register 12 Jan 1928 p 3 – leases approved 5 Jan 1928 include oil & gas lease reported to US Indian Agency, item 52158, Nollis Bunnup (he died the previous month)

From OK, Wills & Probate records” – “In the matter of the Judicial Determination of the heirship of Nollis Bunnup, Deceased” - No. 3489 Probate, in McCurtain County OK, 29 Jun 1929. Frank Yawitz, petitioner/plaintiff vs. William Bunnup & Wisey Bunnup, now Ashshalintubbi, defendants, & unknown heirs. Nollis Bunnup d. on/about 10 Dec 1927 in McCurtain Co. OK, where he was a resident & owned real property (described). He left as his heirs his father, William, Post Office, Eagletown OK & Wise (Post Office, Eagletown OK) who claim an interest in his land. A notice was published in the “Broken Bow Times” beginning 4 Jul 1929 for four consecutive issues that he had died intestate [without a will] in or near Broken Bow OK. It appears in the final section (at the bottom of a page) at his “heirs” [terminology used] are only his father William, who was declared the heir & inherited the entire estate. (see the 1957 entry below)

“Duncan (OK) Eagle” 28 Mar 1957 p 4 – S.R. Brown, plaintiff vs. William Bunnup, et al., defendants in Stephens County District Court OK. Notice to William Bunnup, sole heir of Nollis Bunnup, Choctaw Full Blood Indian Roll No. 2255, deceased, and A.Z. Leight, if living. Brown filed that he is the owner of a title in fee simple of Bunnup property.
