Funeral services will be held Tuesday for Neil A. (Art) Nelson of Mountain View, a retired engineer, who died of an apparent heart attack Saturday night in his trailer home.

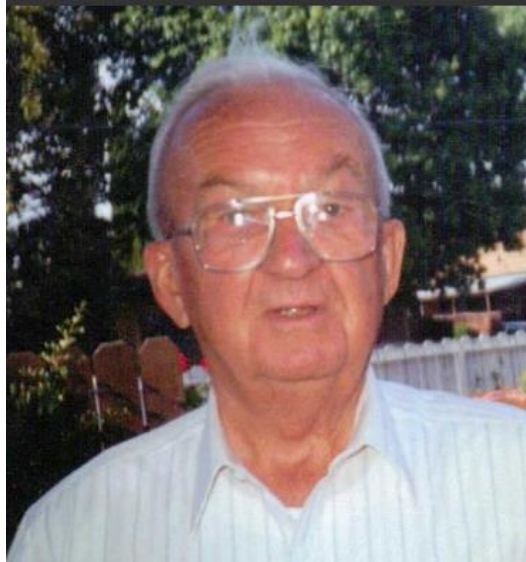
