ANOTHER KILLING

AT DEESE. MACK BAILEY
SHOOTS HIS BROTHER-IN-
LAW BILL HUNT. CAUSE
NOT KNOWN

The erstwhile quiet and peaceful community of Deese, about 8 miles northwest of Ardmore, was the scene of another killing last Sunday, when Mack Bailey shot and fatally wounded his brother-in-law, Bill Hunt, both residents of that community. Bailey was arrested by deputy sheriff Hale Dunn and brought to jail to await the result of Hunt's injuries, and after he died on Monday the county attorney's office filed a murder charge against Bailey. It is said that a preliminary hearing will be had before justice of the peace L. L. Dunlap, at Wilson on Friday.

The officers making the arrest said he could learn nothing of the cause of the shooting, but general rumor has it that it grew out of domestic difficulties. Bailey persistently refuses to make any statement of the cause of the trouble. This is the second killing in that locality within a month. A negro was shot and killed out there on a Sunday about a month ago.

Mack Bailey Will Be Arraigned for Murder of Relative

Mack Bailey of Reck, charged with having shot and killed William Hunt, his brother-in-law, last Sunday, will be arraigned before L. L. Dunlap, justice of the peace, at Wilson this morning, it was learned at the county attorney's office yesterday. Bailey has been held in the county jail since soon after the shooting. Hunt died Monday afternoon as a result of the injuries sustained. Cause of the shooting has not been learned further than the assertion that it was the result of family troubles.

BAILEY TRIED ON MURDER CHARGE

Accused of Killing Brother-in-Law Near Wilson.

Trial of M. A. Bailey, charged with the slaying on May 3 last of his brother-in-law, William Hunt, south of Wilson, was begun in district court this afternoon.

The jury selected from an open venire to try the case includes A. H. Cornell, George Corhn, J. O. Taylor, J. Sam Lane, T. H. Banks, B. B. Nelson, G. P. Selvidge, E. R. Robinson, Reece Evans, J. S. Cornell, H. W. Cunningham and W. C. Baker.

Bailey, who is a farmer, is alleged to have shot and killed Hunt during a quarrel said to have been caused by domestic difficulties. The latter died on the day following the shooting at a Wilson hospital.

In the selection of a jury this afternoon the state exercised two of its peremptory challenges. The defense did not challenge.

The extreme penalty was not demanded in the case.

BAILEY MURDER CASE TO JURORS IN RECORD TIME

Late Night Session Held To Complete Case; Speed In Entire Trial.

BULLETIN

Deliberating less than forty minutes the jury in the case of M. A. Bailey, charged with the murder of his brother-in-law, last night at 11:45 returned a verdict guilty of manslaughter in the first degree and recommended that his sentence be 20 years in the state penitentiary. The case was one of the speediest murder trials on record in the local courts.

Working at record speed, the case of M. A. Bailey, charged with the murder of William Hunt, his brother-in-law, was completed last night at a special night session and the case given to the jury. The court, presided over by Judge Asa Walden, began trial of the case yesterday at noon. The jury was selected in record time, the state exercising two of its challenges and the defense waiving all preemptory dismissals.

Presentation of evidence was in progress throughout the afternoon and was completed at a night session that continued until nearly 11 o'clock. Argument by counsel started at 9 o'clock. Brevity was the feature of the counsels' statements to the jurors and every effort was made to hasten completion of the case in record time.

The state did not demand the death penalty in the case.

Bailey is alleged to have shot and killed Hunt as the result of a quarrel over domestic relations. The slaying took place south of Wilson when the two men met on May 3, last. Bailey, a farmer, fired on Hunt who was mortally wounded dying in a Wilson hospital.

20- YEARS FOR BAILEY URGED

Convicted of Manslaughter By
Jury in Less Than 40
Minutes Deliberation.

Within less than 40 minutes from the time the case had been placed in their hands for consideration, a jury in district court returned a verdict of manslaughter against M. A. Bailey at 11:45 last night. Punishment was recommended at 20 years in the state penitentiary.

Formal sentence will be passed this week by District Judge Asa E. Walden, before whom the case was tried.

Bailey was alleged to have shot and killed his brother-in-law, William Hunt, following a quarrel on the night of May 3 last. The shooting took place south of Wilson. Hunt was mortally wounded and died in a Wilson hospital the following day.

The case started yesterday afternoon and was completed late last night.

Self-defense was the plea interposed by the defendant.

M. A. BAILEY CONVICTED GIVEN TWENTY YEARS

M. A. Bailey was tried in the district court on Monday on the charge of murder for having killed his brother-in-law, William Hunt, last May, several miles south of Wilson. The cause of the killing was said to have been domestic troubles. The big news feature of the trial however was, that the case was taken up and completed within one day, and that the jury was accepted without exceptions from the defendant, and the state having peremptorily challenged but two. The following were the jurors accepted, and who tried the case, finding the defendant guilty and recommending a sentence of 20 years in the penitentiary:— A. H. Cornell, George Corbin, J. C. Taylor, J. S. Lane, T. H. Banks, B. B. Nelson, G. P. Selvidge, E. R. Robinson, Reese Evans, J. S. Cornell, H. W. Cunningham, and W. C. Baker. The case was started about 11:00 o'clock a. m. and the jury returned its verdict at 11:00 o'clock that night.

Bailey's counsel will ask for a new trial, it is said.

BAILEY'S FATE RESTS WITH JURY

Argument of Counsel Is Completed and District Judge Ogden Instructs Jury.

The jury this afternoon held the fate of M. A. Bailey, who is being tried for the second time on a charge of murder in connection with the killing of his brother in law, William Hunt, near Wilson last May.

Argument of counsel was completed and the case given to the jury shortly after noon, following the reading of instructions to the jury by Judge John B. Ogden, before whom the case is being tried.

Bailey is alleged to have shot and killed Hunt after challenging him to a fight on a public highway in front of A. J. Chastain home between Wilson and Orr on the afternoon of Sunday May 2. Witnesses testified that Bailey shot his brother in law two times, once in the head and the chest, as he climbed from his car. Bailey was said to have left the scene immediately following the shooting. Family troubles are believed to have been the cause of the differences between the two men.

At his first trial during the fall term of district court, Bailey was given a 20-year sentence in the penitentiary. He asked for a new trial, which at first was refused. The motion, however, was sustained in October and the case set for the present term.

MOTION FOR NEW TRIAL IS FILED

M. A. Bailey, Convicted of Manslaughter, Makes Move.

M. A. Bailey, who was found guilty of manslaughter by a jury in district court Thursday night and sentenced to four years in the penitentiary, filed a motion in district court today for a new trial. The motion alleged that the court erred in several sections of the instructions, and that the jury was allowed to examine a pistol that was not introduced as evidence in the trial.

Bailey was convicted of killing his brother-in-law, William Hunt, during a quarrel believed to have arisen from family troubles. The killing occurred on a highway near Wilson last May 2.

He was tried at the fall term of court and was given a 20-year sentence but filed motion for a new trial, which was granted.

Motions for new trial in three criminal cases were heard yesterday in Judge John B. Ogden's division of the district court and all overruled and appeals granted.

M. A. Bailey, who was convicted of manslaughter in the first degree in connection with the killing of William Hunt, between Wilson and Orr, last May 2, the jury fixing his punishment at four years in the state penitentiary, filed a motion for a new trial and this was the first heard yesterday morning. The motion was overruled and sentence imposed according to the verdict. He prayed an appeal to the court of criminal appeals and this was granted.

The defendant was given ninety days in which to prepare and serve case made. The supercedas bond was fixed at \$4,000 and ten days allowed in which to make it. Guy Sigler, one of defendant's attorneys, said the bond had already been made.





**COUNTY OFFICERS GET
QUANTITY OF "CHOC"**

D. Bell and Monroe Gunter destroyed more than two hundred bottles of "home brew" at the homes of Lewis Turpin and Mack Bailey in the southwest part of the city Saturday. Daughter of Joseph Wyatt Hunt (1844-1929, F: 96269232) & Margaret Elizabeth (Lizzie) Chambers (1866-1908). Joseph's Find A Grave has a long list of her siblings attached to the record. Joseph Hunt was the son of Charlie Hunt & Liddie Louisa Williams. J.W. Hunt married M.E. Chambers on 25 Dec 1880 in Brown Co. TX.

In the 1910 census for Hewitt, Carter OK, Leddie Hunt, age 9, b. OK, lived with her parents Joseph W. Hunt (53 TX, father b. TN, mother b. TX, widowed, farmer on a general farm). The household includes her older brother, William D. Hunt (age 11, b. OK).

Their relationship might have soured when Mack was tried in court for murdering her brother, William Dewey (Bill) Hunt (3 Feb 1899 Indian Territory – 3 May 1926 Wilson, Carter OK), and sentenced to serve a sentence in the Oklahoma State Penitentiary, Bucklesby, Pittsburg OK.

Marriage: 3 Jul 1919 in Reck, Carter OK. Mack was age 23; Liddie Hunt was age 19. Are they the Lydia and Mack Bailey whose divorce case appeared in the newspaper in Jun 1931?

Spouse: Cora Effie Baucom Bailey Roever, 3 Nov 1903 Oklahoma City, Oklahoma Co. OK – 31 Jul 1984 Healdton, Carter OK. Daughter of James William Baucom (1865-1942, F: 19791019) & Elizabeth/Elisabeth Ida McMillan (1869-1946, F: 19828316). Buried in Reck Cemetery, Wilson, Carter OK.

Marriage: In the 1930 census, Mack was listed as married while a prisoner in the OK State Penitentiary & Cora Baucom, single, resided with her parents. In the 1940 census, Cora is married to Mack Bailey.

TX, lived with her aunt & uncle, Newt Odam (28 TX), a laborer in the oil fields) & Clara (20 AR, parents b. AR.) – Juanita was married to Thomas A. Kennedy (1914-1994, F: 28344294). - Juanita Kennedy resided in Salinas CA at the time of her father's death in 1950. – Several erroneous Ancestry.com records list her supposed OK school records, but those are for a Black family & a different birth date than

hers. She is also linked to marriages to a Moody & a Love. - Buried in Mission Memorial Park, Seaside, Monterey CA. F; 218344339

- Elizabeth Bailey King. Elizabeth King resided in Salinas CA at the time of her father's death in Nov 1950. There are numerous Elizabeth Bailey marriage records in OK & CA & she may have remarried after Nov 1950. Could not trace.

- Tennessee (Tennie) Bailey Bray?, Apr 1878 Fannin Co. TX - . Dead by Aug 1958. Online family trees are confusing & confused. Some list a death date of May 1899 in Healdton, Carter OK – but “Linnie” (or Tinnie/Tennie) is alive in the 1900 census, single, living with her parents as of 25 Jun 1900. A newspaper report indicates a Tennie Bailey obtained a marriage license with E.S. Bray in May 1897, when she was 19 years old & he 22, both residents of Healdton, Carter OK. Family trees list her marriage to Elbert L. (E.L.) Bray on 2 May 1897 in Healdton, Carter OK. A Walter W. Bray died Jun 1936; he had been born 13 Feb 1898 in Healdton, Carter OK & was survived by his father Elbert Bray & his stepmother.
- Joseph Washington (Joe) Bailey, 30 Nov 1879 (Dec 1881 in 1900 census) Jacksboro, Fannin Co. TX – 17 Jun 1953 Carter Co. OK. Husband of Atley Belle Rennels (1882-1964, F: 197909810) whom he married 15 Nov 1900 in Healdton, Carter OK. Buried in Reck Cemetery, Wilson, Carter OK. F:19790992
- Mollie (Molly) E. Bailey Burris Stratton, 10 Dec 1882 Fannin Co. TX (date on OR death certificate, but Dec 1883 TX in 1900 census) – 11 Dec 1964 Albany, Linn OR. Listed as surviving sister Mrs. Mollie Strickland of Oregon in brother James's Aug 1958 obituary & as Mollie Stratton of Albany OR in Jun 1953. Married 22 Nov 1900 in Healdton, Carter OK to Marion A. Burris (1871-1933, F: 106218570) – Widowed, Mollie Burris married Lawrence Wilson Stratton (1882 AR – 1972 OR, F: 146045045) in Wellington, Collingsworth TX on 25 Nov 1935. Buried in Willamette Memorial Park, Albany, Linn OR. F: 146045081
- Dovie Bailey Watson, 20 Dec 1884 Leonard, Fannin TX (Jul 1886 TX in 1900 census) – 1 Aug 1954 Floydada, Floyd TX. Married 11 Jan 1903 in Healdton, Carter OK to Jerome E. Watson (1879-1973, F: 152393654). Buried in Dreamland Cemetery, Canyon, Randall TX. F: 26142676
- John Shaw Bailey, 13 Aug 1888 Fannin Co. TX (Mar 1888 TX in 1900 census) – 12 Feb 1946 Clovis, Curry, NM. Husband of Laura Alice Murtishaw (1893-1936, F: 34768110). Ancestry.com also lists a wife named Leona Smith. Buried in Resthaven Cemetery, Quitaque, Briscoe TX. F: 34768172
- Susie Cindy Bailey Battle, 20 Jul 1891 TX (Feb 1893 TX in 1900 census) – 16 Dec 1963 Lockney, Floyd TX. Wife of Robert Joe Battle (1887-1965, F: 119415158). Listed as surviving sister Tizzie Battles in Jun 1953. - Buried in Lockney Cemetery, Lockney, Floyd TX. F: 119435223
- James Roscoe (Jim) Bailey, 20 Jul 1893 Jack Co. TX (Sep 1894 in 1900 census) – 28 Aug 1958 Ardmore, Carter OK. Married 24 Dec 1916 at Rose Hill to Myrtle Rosetta

Henderson (1898-1958, F: 25351892). Buried in Hewitt Cemetery, Wilson, Carter OK. F: 25351896

Notes:

This is a difficult family to research. There are several men named Mack Bailey in the Wilson OK/Hewitt OK area. Many family trees online are erroneous. His alleged son Mackie DeRoy Bailey (1 Apr 1919 – 4 Jul 1980, both Carter Co. OK) is the son of Mack's brother, Joseph Washington Bailey.

OK School Enrollment – at Wilson, Carter OK, Mack Bailey, age 18, b. 20 May 1894, son of J.A. Bailey, in the Black Jack District

Wartime:

Post-war:

On 2 May 1926 (although the date sometimes switches to 3 May 1926), Mack Bailey shot his brother-in-law, William Dewey Hunt, in Carter Co. OK. William died the next day (3 May 1926). This was due to "family troubles" or "domestic disturbances." Mack was originally tried for murder, although the death penalty was not part of the considerations, found guilty of manslaughter in the 1st degree & sentenced to 20 years in the state penitentiary, then at Bucklesby, Pittsburg OK, where he is incarcerated in the 1930 census.

Mack appealed the original trial but the second trial, in May 1927, again found him guilty, this time of manslaughter, with a sentence of 4 years. He appealed again; in Aug 1929, the sentence was affirmed. He was paroled in Feb 1932.

Mack's name is listed in the "Tulsa (OK) World" of Sunday, 24 Jun 1934, page 9, in a lengthy list of paroled convicts, in a critical article about the liberal granting of pardons by Oklahoma Governor William Henry Murray (served 1931-1935) entitled "Oklahoma's Prison Gates Opened Wide by Governor."
