WISCONSIN SURVIVORS ON TUSCANIA

WASHINGTON, Feb. 9.—Seventy-nine Wisconsin men who were on the transport Tuscania sunk by a torpedo are known to have been saved, the war department announced today.

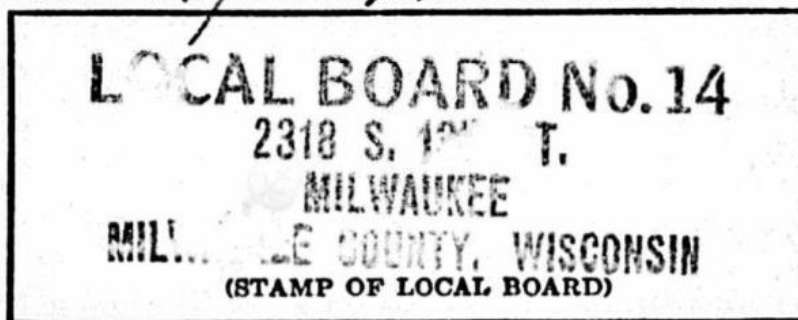
