(Associated Press Report.)

SAN ANTONIO, Texas, Feb. 11.—Word was received here Monday of the safety of Sergeant Pedro Belton of 107 South Leona street, who was aboard the British steamship *Tuscania* when torpedoed off the coast of Ireland last Wednesday. Information of the safety of Sergeant Belton came in a telegram from the war department, through the adjutant general of the State, to his mother, Mrs. Alder Belton, also of 107 South Leona street.

Sergeant Belton is 22 years old and a native of Laredo, Texas, coming to San Antonio four years ago with his parents. He was inducted into the military service of the country by the local draft board of Bexar county and received training at Camp Travis.

FT. WORTH MAN AND MANY OTHER TEXANS FROM LOST U. S. TRANSPORT RECOVERING IN IRISH HOSPITALS

(Associated Press)

WASHINGTON, Feb. 24.—Sixty-three American survivors of the torpedoed troop ship *Tuscania* were reported to the war department today as recovering in Irish hospitals from the effects of in-

juries or exposure. The dispatch said none of the cases was serious and that it was expected all the men would soon be discharged.

All of the sixty-three had previously been reported saved and the presence of many of them in hospitals had been recorded in press dis-

patches, although today's dispatch brought the first official list of those in hospitals. The list included:

Realtors Paint House, Honor Newspaperman

With their first "good turn" project completed and an award presented posthumously to a "well-beloved" newspaperman, members of the San Antonio Real Estate Board, Inc., today regard-

ed Realtor Week activities the past week highly successful.

Major project of the week, a seriously needed paint job on the home of an ailing World War I veteran, was completed Tuesday with more than 40 volunteers participating.

The board's traditional award for "distinguished service to the public" this year went to Charles Treuter, former editor and publisher of the Commercial Recorder who died last December.

The award was presented to Treuter's widow, Mrs. Florence Treuter, by Guy Chipman Jr., board president, at the Realtor Week dinner. Chipman cited Treuter for "devotion far beyond the call of duty over a long period of years in the interests of sports for young people and adults." A crack athlete in his youth, Treuter worked hard virtually all of his life to build interest in the sport of bowling both locally and nationally.

Realtors who attended the reception and dinner dance also heard Lyn E. Davis of Dallas, vice president of the National Association of Real Estate Boards, speak on the topic "The Realtors' Challenge."

The experimental "good turn" project was the painting in one day of the home of Pedro Belton Sr., a World War I veteran and father of a family of four, at 1122 Mason St. Belton was wounded and gassed in the Argonne Woods campaign.

Squads of Realtors, working in shifts, painted the entire exterior of the modest but sound structure which Belton had been unable to have painted for a number of years simply because he could not afford the cost.

"We tried to give the public an example of practicing what you preach," said Bob Jones, chairman of Realtor Week. "We continually urge homeowners to maintain their houses properly and this home, unpainted for years, was located in the midst

of a number of well-maintained houses. The paint job definitely upgraded the entire area."

On the day of the painting, Belton was at Brooke General Hospital undergoing a minor operation. In addition to his wife, his family consists of Mary Lou, 18, and a senior at Tech High who works after school and at night to earn some family income; Robert, 16, also a Tech student and part-time worker; Mathilde, 14, and Roger, 11. Mrs. Belton takes in ironing to help out financially.

"We hope," said Steve Pogue Sr., chairman of the painting project, "that other organizations will follow our lead in helping indigent but deserving families to rehabilitate their homes."

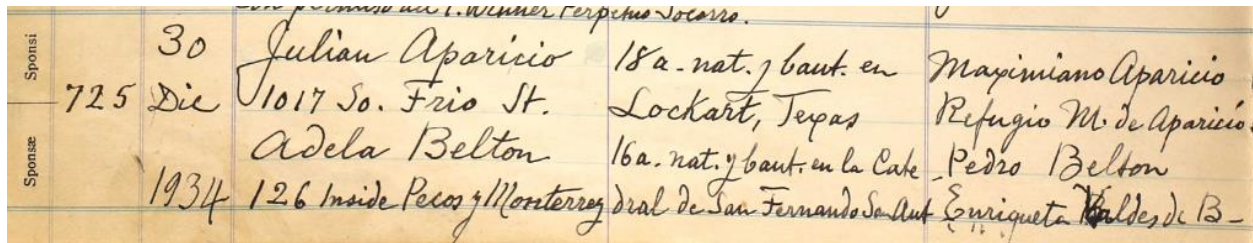

Pedro was wounded & gassed in WWI at the Argonne Woods. Painting was done by squads of Realtors working in shifts. Realtors urge homeowners to maintain their houses. Bob James, Realtor Week chairman, said the house, unpainted for years, was in the midst of well-maintained houses and now makes the area look better. On the day the house was painted, Pedro was at Brooke General Hospital for a minor operation. He lives there with his wife and four children: Mary Lou (18), a senior at Tech High who works after school & nights to help the family, Robert (16), also at Tech High, a part-time worker, 14-year-old Mathilda & 11-year-old Roger. Realtors hope other organizations will help indigent but deserving families. Pedro's wife takes in ironing as a job.
