Beaumont Man Burns To Death After Crash

BEAUMONT, April 15 (AP).— Joe Bennight, 28, was fatally burned Thursday when his bread truck hit a bridge, overturned and caught fire near Kirbyville.

Critically burned in the crash was Bobby Davenport, 15, of Beaumont, son of W. M. Davenport of Tyler.

The accident occurred on Highway 69 as a heavy rain was falling in the Kirbyville area. Highway patrolmen said the truck apparently skidded on the slick highway into the bridge.


