



Herbert E. Benson, 73, a World War I Army veteran, died Tuesday in Phoenix Veterans Hospital.

Mr. Benson, 1801 Grand Ave., a retired laborer who was born in St. Paul, Minn., moved here 25 years ago from Montana. He had no known survivors.

Services will be at 11 a.m. tomorrow in A.L. Moore and Sons Mortuary, 333 W. Adams. Burial will be in Ft. Whipple VA Cemetery at Prescott.





- Roy Walter. Benson, 12 Oct 1900 St. Paul, Ramsey MN 17 Feb 1956 Rochester, Monroe NY. In the 1930 census, Roy (29 MN, single) a land surveyor, parents b. Sweden, is a lodger with Joe & Vivian Ackerman at 23 N. Ann St., Chicago, Cook IL. In 1930, In May 1932, when Herbert is admitted to the Sawtelle CA Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, he gives Roy as his next-of-kin but indicates he does not know Roy's address. When he registers for the WWII draft on 26 Feb 1942, his address is given as 100 W. 45th St., NYC, NY, which is crossed off, then that is crossed off, with various notes that are also crossed off: next-of-kin Miss Ann Hall of the same address, employment at Phils Recreation, 1165 6th Ave., NYC, NY, then a date of 5/8/41 for the 1165 6th Ave. address, with "bowling alley" added. He is 5'6" & weights 145 lbs. In1950, Roy W. Benson, 49 MN, never married, is employed at the Iola Sanitorium as a kitchen helper in the hospital. He is a "partner" (roommate) of George C. Elkins, 70 MA, never married, employed in the same job. Roy's obituary mentions his surviving brother, Herbert E. Benson, in St. Paul MN. Buried in Mount Hope Cemetery, Rochester, Monroe MN. F: 138386631
- And 2 siblings deceased between 1900 & 1910 censuses. One appears to be a boy, born 27 Aug 1889 in St. Paul, Ramsey MN. Although the parents of a girl born 2 Dec 1889 in St. Paul, Ramsey MN also are listed as John & Ida Benson, she appears to be the Alice Victoria Benson who lives until 1936 & has different siblings in census records.
