I am not sure of the connecton; but think I may have an answer regarding Daniel Bickford's family.

I am working on my family info in Minneapolis and I have come across Frank J. Bickford with children James, Daniel, Gertrude and John. Frank married Maggie Taylor sister to Nellie Taylor who married into my family.

Maggie died in 1909, the 1910 Census lists Frank Bickford as Widower living in a rooming house. The children (spelled Burford) are living with their maternal grandmother Mary McKune.

McKune was a second marriage, her first was to Joseph Taylor. Her maiden name was Blake. Her death info lists James Blake born in England as her father. I am including my findings on Ancestry.com trees. Mary McKune (also spelled McCune in other records) died 1913, again leaving the children. Mary had 4 daughters and one son. I know at least 2 if not 3 of the daughters died prior to her death. It is possible the children went to live with another realitive. I think by 1920, the oldest, James (J. Frank in census) is married and John living with him.

I have not completed searching this line.

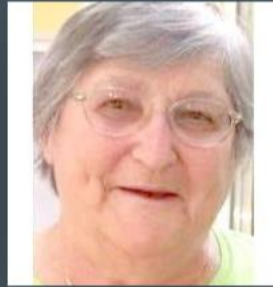

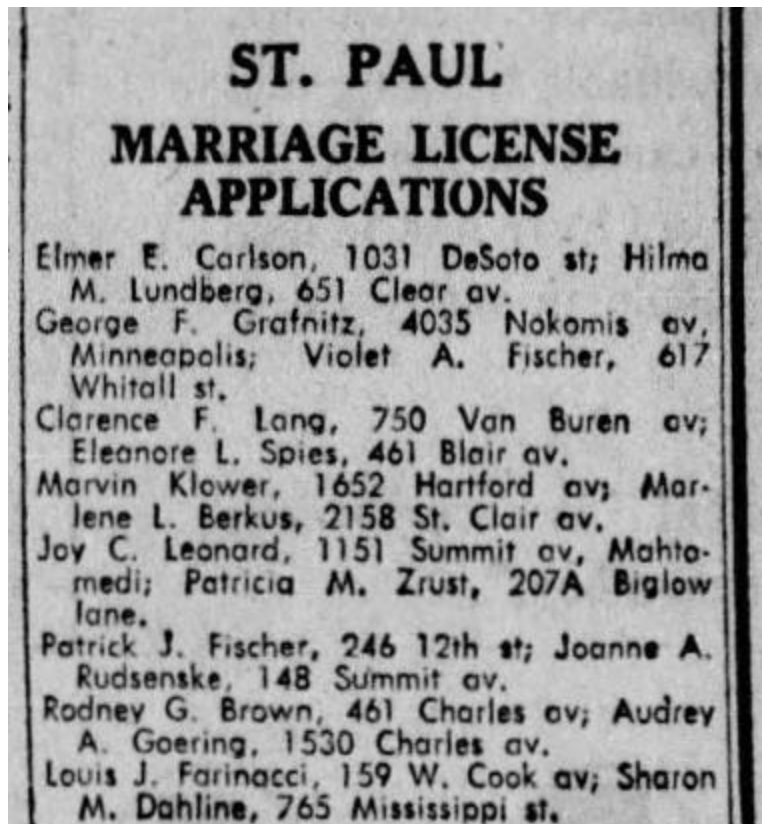

On 12 May 1921, Violet McCue married to Dell David Milligan (Jun 1898 NE – May 1958 OR, F: 47097688). His name is sometimes found as D.B. Milligan.

Their daughter was Videll Milligan (ca. 1929 OR – 28 Feb 2004 Florence OR) who married Ernest Jesse Marshall (5 Jun 1905 Humphrey AR-26 Dec 1979 Albany OR) on 5 Jul 1949 in Clark Co. WA.

Violet & husband Dell Milligan lived in 1930 in Coquille, Coos OR. Dell D. Milligan (31 NE, father b. MI, mother b. IN, age 21 at 1<sup>st</sup> marriage) was a hook tender in a logging camp.

Violet J. was age 27 OR, father b. OR, mother b. CA & daughter Videll was age 8 months, b. OR.

In their divorce petition, filed by Dell on 27 Oct 1941 in Coos Co. OR, he said he & Violet had separated 15 Sep 1938. He charged her with desertion; no children were involved. The divorce was granted 2 Dec 1941.

Dell Milligan is buried in Sunset Memorial Park, Coos Bay, Coos OR. He had married Sarah Nancy Farrier Hamblock Rosendale on 1 Aug 1942 in Coquille, Coos OR. She survived him. Sarah Nancy Farrier was the daughter of Henry Alfred Farrier (1885-1953, F: 117251267) & Iva May Sydnam (1885-1941, F: 117251405). She had married Jess J. Hamblock on 3 Jul 1924. She sued for divorce, charging cruelty, with 1 child involved; the divorce was granted 27 Dec 1927.

Then Sarah Hamblock married Archie Elmer Rosendale (1897-1957, F: 3928879), son of Isaac Adolph Rosendale & Briita Maria Tapio, on 9 Jun 1928 in Vancouver, Clark WA.

Untruths on the marriage license indicate it is her 2<sup>nd</sup> marriage & that her father was H.A. Hamblock (not Farrier) & her mother Iva "Sydda" [illegible] Sarah Milligan died 29 Mar 1968 in San Diego Co. CA.

In 1940, Violet Milligan was living with her brother, Leonard J. White (40 CA, divorced), the head of household, in Florence, Lane OR. Leonard was a laborer in a logging camp. Violet was age 37, b. OR & daughter Videlle [sic] O. Milligan was age 4, b. OR. In 1935 Leonard had lived in rural Curry Co. OR while Violet & Videll lived in Coquille, Coos OR.

In various obituaries, Videll Milligan Marshall is described as the "sister" and "brother" of people with a variety of surnames, not all of which can be explained as women's married names: Fred L. #### Pre-war:

Daniel's mother Margaret died in 1909. In 1910, he & his siblings are living with their maternal grandmother, Mary Blake Taylor McKune/McCune, in Minneapolis MN while their father lives in a boarding house in Minneapolis MN. Mary McKune dies 18 Sep 1913 in Hennepin Co. MN.

Apparently Daniel rejoins the Army after his WWI service as he is found at Fort Mills in the Philippines as of Oct 1919. A muster roll for 30 Sep 1922 also lists him in Manila, Philippines but transferred to the CAC. He sails back from Manila to San Francisco CA aboard the ship "Thomas" on 11 Sep 1922. He is a private with serial number 251,249 [which matches that of WWI]. The list of men aboard is headed "troop class, subsisted, free cont'd (Eighth Provisional Co.)" on the ship roster. This serial number is also used in the US Army muster rolls for units in Manila Bay, Philippine Islands.
