SNYDER — Capt. Samuel Terry, 69, of Concord, Calif., who was one of the first American commercial flyers to land on the mainland of China in more than 20 years, died Thursday in Concord.

Memorial graveside services will be at 11 a.m. Wednesday at Hillside Memorial Gardens in Snyder with the Rev. Miller Robinson officiating, directed by Bell-Cypert-Seale Funeral Home.

He was born in Linden and moved to Snyder with his family in 1925. He graduated from Snyder High School in 1939 and from John Tarleton Agricultural College in 1941.

He retired as an airline pilot in 1981 from Trans-American Airlines, based in Concord. He was a pilot in China for China National Airways after World War II.

After leaving China, he moved to Manila, where he flew for Philippine Airlines until 1949, when he moved back to Snyder for a short time.

Survivors include his wife, Miggs Terry of Concord; five daughters, Ramona Chance of Greenville, Gail Eubank of Sacramento, Calif., Julia E. Terry of Oakland, Calif., and Missy Marshall and Christina Terry, both of Concord; two sons, Tony Terry of Walnut Creek, Calif., and Peter Terry of Concord; his mother, Mrs. S.L. Terry of Snyder; a sister, Evelyn Alexander of Lago Vista; two nieces; and an aunt.

Born Milagros Ramona O'Brien on August 16, 1926, in Manila, Philippines, passed on August 16, 2005, at home in Concord, Calif. She was predeceased by her husband of 43 years, Samuel Edwin, in 1990; and by her son, Tony, in 1996. Miggs leaves six children, Ramona Chance of Frankston, Texas, Gail Eubank of Golden, Colo., Julia Terry of Alameda, Calif., Missy Marshall of Concord, Calif., Christina Terry of Dallas, Texas, and Peter Terry of Concord, Calif. She also leaves 11 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Miggs came to the United States in 1949 with her husband and oldest daughter. The family moved to Snyder, Texas, where she gave birth to her next daughter. They then moved to San Antonio, Texas, where the next three children were born. In 1962 the family moved to a suburb of Kansas City, Kan., and during the next few years her last two children were born. In 1969, the family moved to Concord, Calif., where she has since resided.

Besides her charity work with Meals on Wheels and Loaves and Fishes, Miggs gave her time at the library where her youngest children attended school, as well as being involved in the Catholic Daughters through her parish of St. Agnes in Concord. When not involved with her children or her charitable work, Miggs spent as much time as possible at the bridge or poker tables. She had begun a poker group in Kansas City, and transferred that to Concord after her arrival. She was often fondly referred to as "Mrs. Goren," and was looked to for her expertise in both bridge and poker.

A funeral Liturgy will be held at St. Bonaventure Church on August 19, 2005, at 10 a.m. A vigil and visitation will be held at Ouimet Funeral Chapel on Thursday, August 18, 2005, from 4 to 8 p.m.; vigil at 7 p.m. Donations can be sent in lieu of flowers to Hospice of Contra Costa.
