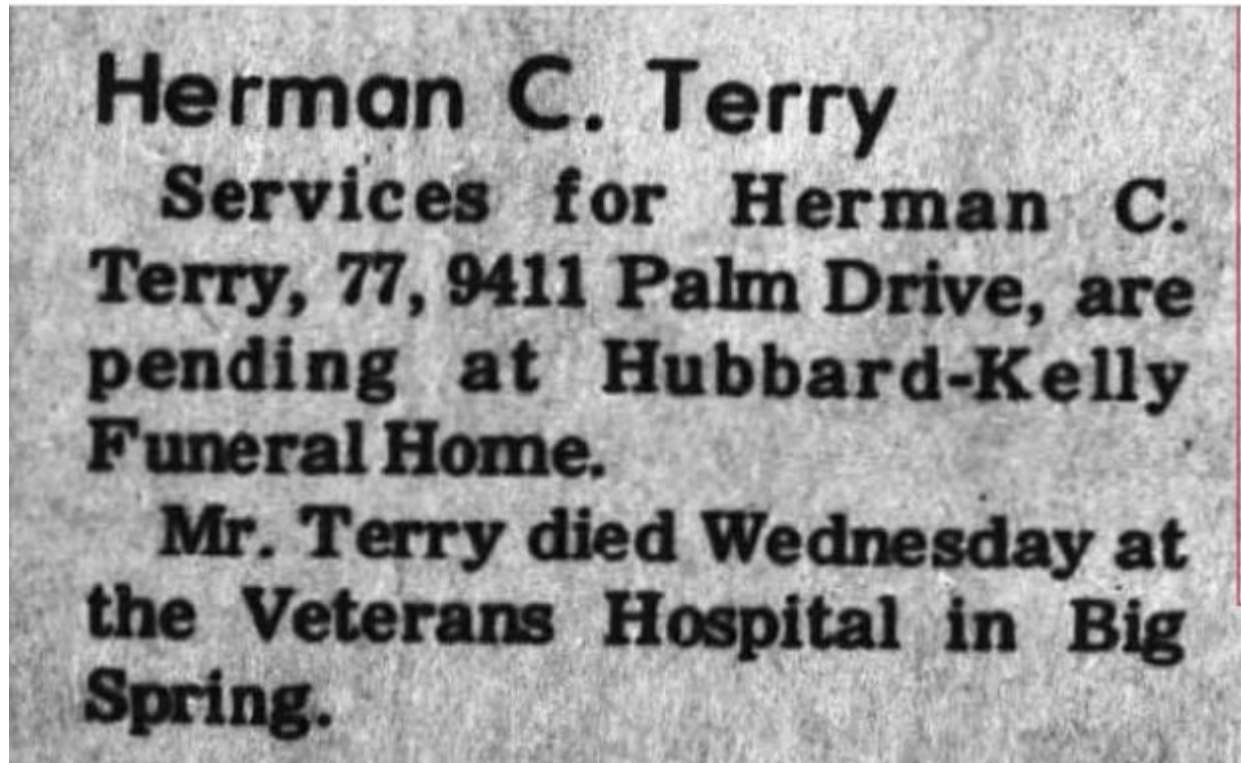
Mrs. Willis was born in Arkansas in 1891. She resided in Wichita county on the Iowa Park road for the last 18 years where her husband farmed.
