Archie B. Tesseyman, 21 years old, of 508 Seventeenth avenue, Long Island City, enlisted early in December and was assigned to the 213th Aero Squadron. He was employed as an architect by the New York Architectural and Terra Cotta Company at Long Island City before his enlistment. He has a brother-in-law, James McGuffie, now in France with an Engineer Corps, and a nephew, Walter McGuffie, in the Aviation Corps at Mineola.

FRIENDS LOST ON TUSCANIA

Drowning of Bartolomeo and Maystrick Confirmed.

Long Island City, Feb. 19.—The family of Corp. Adolph Bartolomeo, 28, of 572 Tenth avenue, received official notice from Washington yesterday that he was drowned when the Tuscania was sunk by a German submarine on February 8. Bartolomeo was born in Italy but came to this country with his parents when only a small child. He was a piano tuner in the factory of Steinway & Sons, until his enlistment on December 18, when he was assigned to the 213th Aero Squadron, with which unit he was bound for France when drowned.

His chum, Joseph G. Maystrick, 35, of 30 Clark street, who enlisted in the aviation corps with him, was also drowned and his family has been notified that the body was recovered and buried in Scotland.

Only one of the three Long Island boys on the Tuscania with the 213th Squadron survived. He was Archie Tesseyman, of 508 Seventeenth avenue, whose rescue was announced several days after the sinking.

Mr. Tessyman, who is employed by the New York Architectural Terra-Cotta Company of Long Island City enlisted with the 213th Aero Squadron during the war. His regiment embarked for France aboard the Tuscania. Off the coast of Scotland the ship was torpedoed. Tessyman was among the survivors of the ill-fated ship and was landed in Scotland. During his stay in Scotland awaiting his shipment to France he became acquainted with Miss Mackie. The

couple became engaged and Tessyman was sent to France. They corresponded regularly and Miss Mackie arrived in this country a few days ago. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Peter Mackie of Ayre, Scotland. Mr. Tessyman is the son of John Tessyman of North Henry street, Long Island City.

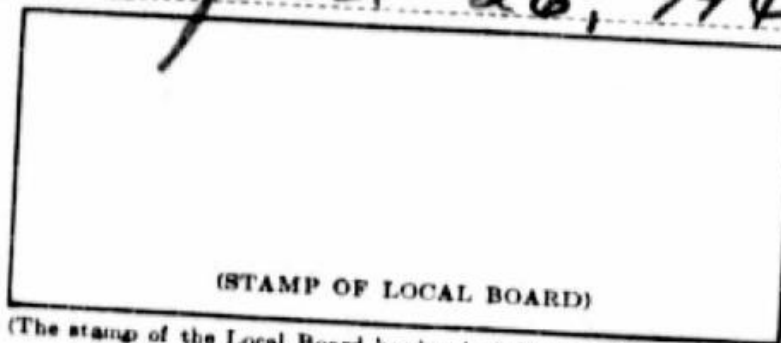
