LONG ILLNESS OF GEORGE THALL ENDED IN DEATH ON MONDAY

The community was saddened Monday evening, June 2, 1947, to learn of the death of George Thall. He passed away at the age of 62 at his home at 104 South Riverside Drive, after an illness of more than a year's duration.

Although a resident of McHenry for less than ten years, Mr. Thall proved himself so capable and active both in his work and in civic undertakings that his untimely passing is mourned by the entire community.

George Thall was born in Alpena, Mich., on Dec. 5, 1884. He graduated from the University of Michigan as a civil engineer, but in later years his interest turned to newspaper work, being employed in an executive capacity from coast to coast. Among leading newspapers on in which he worked were included the

Los Angeles Evening Herald, San Francisco Call-Post, Milwaukee Sentinel, Detroit Free Press and the Chicago Herald and Examiner. With at least three of these papers he acted as classified advertising manager.

Mr. Thall was an active member of the local Legion post, having served as a captain with the 108th engineers during the first World War. As a member of General Pershing's staff, he wrote the history of engineering operations, an official document, during the war. During his service in France he was cited for meritorious service. He narrowly escaped death on his voyage overseas when the Tuscania, a troop ship on which he was riding, was torpedoed off the coast of Ireland.

Mr. and Mrs. Thall came to McHenry from Chicago in March of 1938, after which time he was associated with the Kent Real Estate Co. Following hospitalization in the winter of 1946, he returned to work until last January, when illness prevented him leaving his home.

Survivors include the widow, Jean; one daughter, Mrs. Patricia McCaughna, of Los Angeles, Calif.; and a brother, Fred Thall, of Detroit, Mich.

The body rested at the Jacob Justen Sons funeral home until Wednesday afternoon, when private services were held there.

Page 113:

First Lieutenant George Newton Thall had been preparing for war in France, reading a book about trenches and “no-man’s land.”

Page 148:

In his lifeboat, Lieutenant E. Denman McNear faced the need to get away from the ship, in a leaking lifeboat, a boat so crowded “we could scarcely row” and minus any experienced oarsman, not having a crew member aboard. “Now began a painful hour.” Lieutenant Thall, who had lost hold of a dangling shipside rope and fallen into McNear’s lifeboat with its 65 men on board, stood up among the “absolutely green oarsmen” and began a rowing lesson – the method to row ahead and the way of “backing water.” McNear found a long oar and put it out astern through a lock, and he and another man began working the long oar while Lt. George Andrew Thall continued his coaching. Thall’s perusal of his book on fighting in no-man’s land, his activity when the torpedo hit, was not likely to have provided much pertinent advice.

Southern California Plans Ad Association

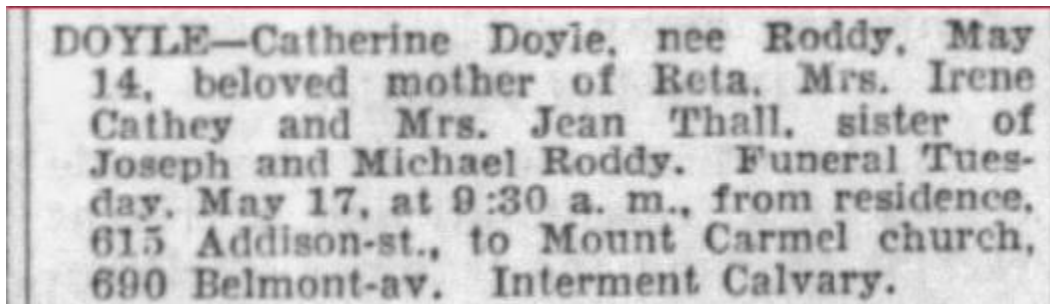
