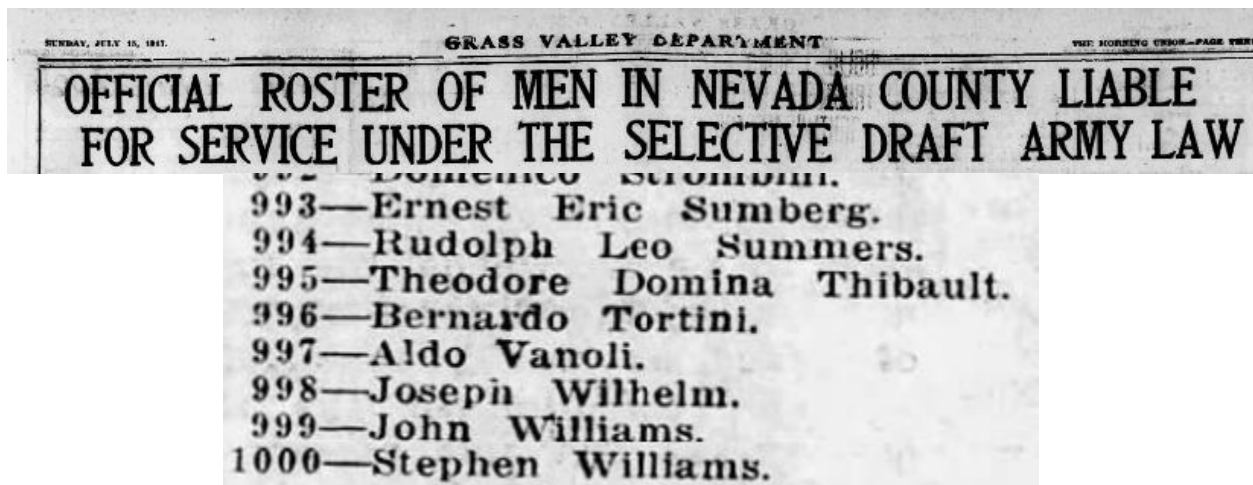

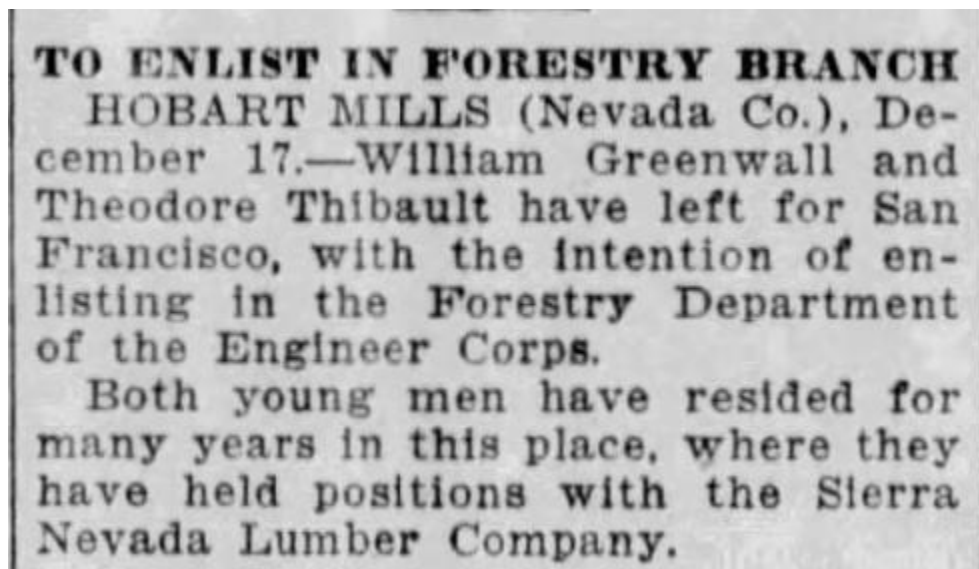

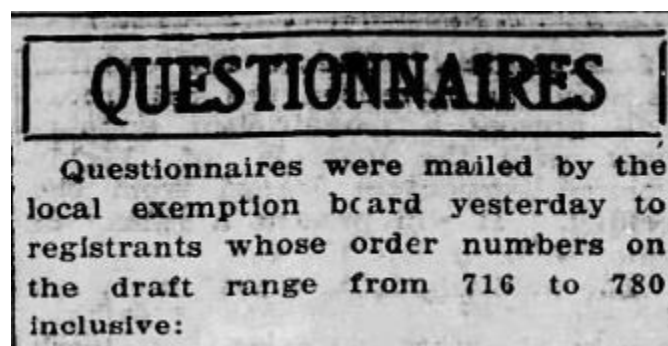

Noisy Reception

Hobart Mills turned out in mass to greet Mr. and Mrs. T. D. Thibault on Monday evening. Early in the evening Mr. and Mrs. Thibault went to Truckee, while they were out of town a group of Mr. Thibault's associates from the Hobart Box Factory went down the road to meet the newlyweds and escort them into town in style. A heavy iron four-wheeled cart used around the plant was decorated with mountain sunflower garlands and a chair fastened to the body of the cart, the chair being gayly decorated with a patchwork quilt and the usual array of cowbells, strings of tin cans and old shoes galore tied to the Lumberman's Chariot.

The aid of Traffic Officer Charles McKee was sought to handle the traffic and all back roads were guarded so that the newlyweds would arrive in town under escort. When within about a mile of town, the traffic officer overtook the car containing Mr. and Mrs. Thibault and with the shrill blasts of the siren passed them and blocked the highway and stopped the car that was being driven by Jack Chubbuck. The newlyweds were taken from the car and placed upon the gayly decorated carriage drawn by about thirty men.

The procession formed led by the traffic officer's car with the siren blowing and the noisy crowd following came into town and were taken to the Hall where preparations were made to hold a reception for Mr. Thibault and his bride. Mr. J. B. Clark, in a few well chosen remarks, presented the couple with an electric mixer with all the attachments. A social hour followed when all had a chance to greet the newlyweds and then they were again asked to mount the decorated carriage and were taken to their home in the conveyance that was built before the days of rubber tires, springs or any shock absorber equipment.

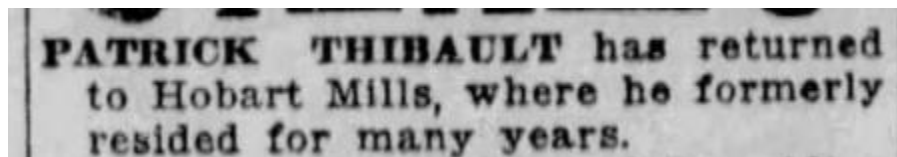

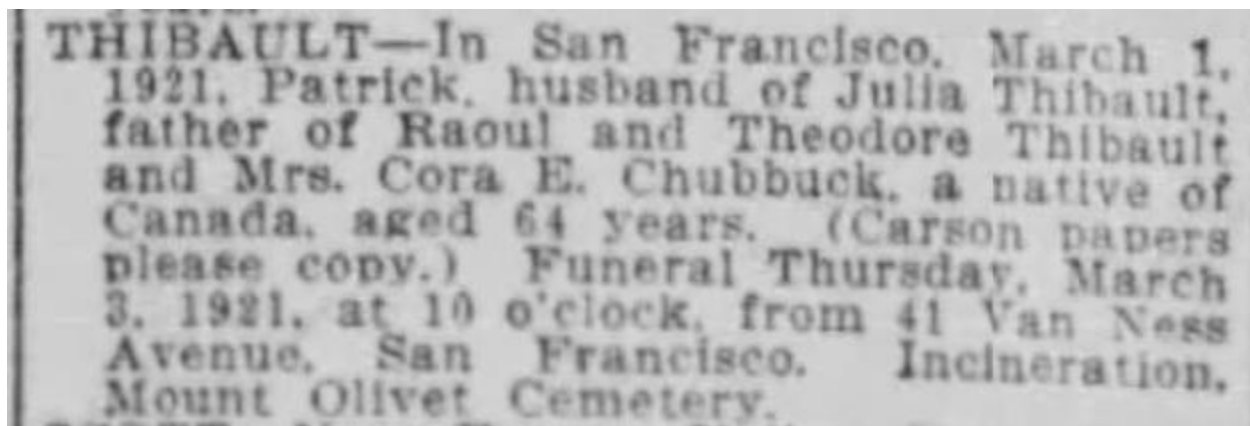

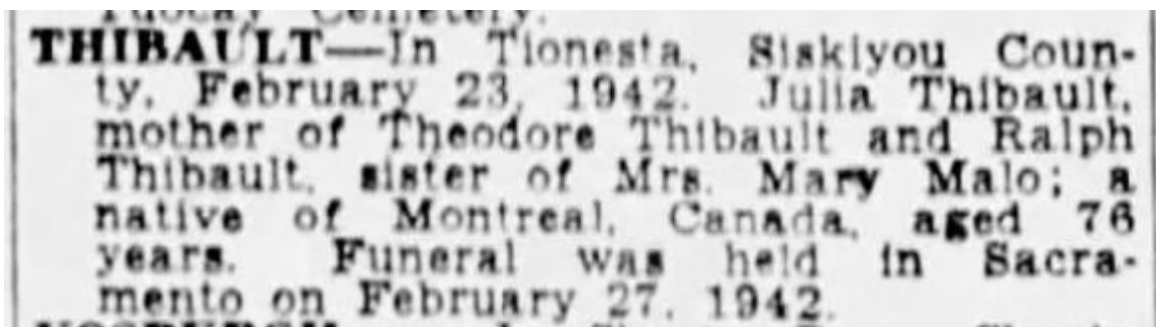
