Emil P. Thomas, aged 26, a World war veteran, died Sunday in the Marine hospital, Fortieth st. and Penn ave. He was a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. John Thomas. During the war, he served in Co. 10, Twentieth engineers. Military funeral services will be held at 8 a. m. tomorrow in the home of his brother, Charles Thomas, 5116 Butler st., followed by services an hour later in St. Augustine's Roman Catholic church, Thirtyseventh st. Ralph W. McNulty post, Veterans of Foreign Wars, will have charge of the military rites.




