



- Anna Peters Cole Thew, Nov 1898 MN -?. Cannot be Andreas Peters's biological daughter as he died 13 Jun 1897. As Anna Cole, married Frank James Thew on 22 Jun 1931 in Hennepin Co. MN. Frank was born in Marietta OH, ca. 1900 (listed as age 35 in the newspaper account beow) or ca. 1904 (WWII draft registration on 14 Feb 1942 listing age as 38 but not including a birthdate). In the "Minneapolis Star" (Tribune?) 6 Dec 1935 p 32, Frank Thew, age 35, of 1435 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. S., Minneapolis MN is arrested after beating his wife, causing 2 broken bones in 1 leg & other injuries. He paid a \$15 fine for assault & battery. She was hospitalized in Minneapolis General Hospital, listed in "fair" condition. Ann M. Thew filed for divorce from Frank J. Thew in Jul 1937 ("Minneapolis Star" 22 Jul 1937 p 12). Listed as Mrs. Frank Thew of Minneapolis MN in the Jul 1937 obituary of her mother Ida Peters. Frank J. Thew had married Helen Blake on 30 Mar 1927 in Hennepin Co. MN; she was granted a divorce in Oct 1929 in Hennepin Co. MN.
- Mary Peters, ca. 1908 MN. Adopted daughter of Ida Peters. In 1910 census, reports father b. Norway & mother b. WI; in 1900 census, parents' birthplaces listed as unknown.
