WASHINGTON, Feb. 2.—The names and home addresses of \$13 survivors of the transport Tuscania has been received at the war department up to 5 o'clock this afternoon.

At that same hour, the department was still without any official figures to dispute its estimate of yesterday that only 113 officers and men of the 2177 American troops on board had lost their lives.

It is expected that the complete list of survivors will be received before the night is over.

Every effort is now being made to expedite the information. Unfortunately, however, for the peace of minds of the hundreds of parents, wives and other relatives who are wiring, telephoning and writing to the war department appealing for information, the list of known dead and missing will probably be the last news to come.


