Resident of Vader Passes

VADER, July 28.—William Thomas Toomey, 65-year-old resident here, passed away Thursday in a veterans' hospital at Walla Walla. Born October 14, 1884, in Pittston, Pa., he had lived in Vader for the past 40 years.

Toomey was well-known in western Lewis county. A former prize fighter, he went by the name of McPadden during his boxing career.

Surviving are a brother, T. J. Toomey, and a sister, Mrs. Anna O'Brien, both of Vader. Funeral services will be held at 9 a. m. Tuesday at the Catholic church here, with the Rev. Father Rowland officiating. Interment at the local cemetery will follow.

In the opinion of men who have been watching him work out, Billy McFadden, who is to meet Jack Carpenter here next Monday evening, will prove a hard nut for the Boise fighter to crack. He is a rough goer, willing to mix it up lively and exchange swats. With such a man as his opponent, Carpenter may have a harder time of disposing of his man for in his previous bouts here he has been pitted against a cleverer defensive fighter and was forced to carry the brunt of the battle throughout.

Carpenter is working out every afternoon also, finishing with a four round mill with Dudley Evans which is no tame affair. Carpenter is a man who hits to hurt but it has not yet been demonstrated here how much punishment he can absorb. Neither Fred Sax or Montana Kid was able to damage him with their blows but McFadden is a bigger and stronger man and is said to have a good haymaker.

When Billy McFadden, the middle-weight boxer who is to meet Jack Carpenter here Monday night, was doing roadwork yesterday morning, he took the railroad track and ran toward Barnhart. 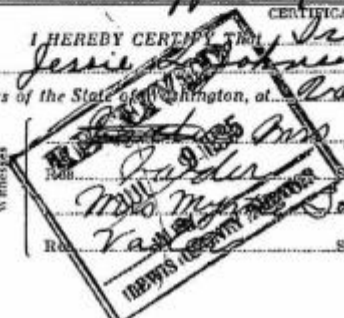
