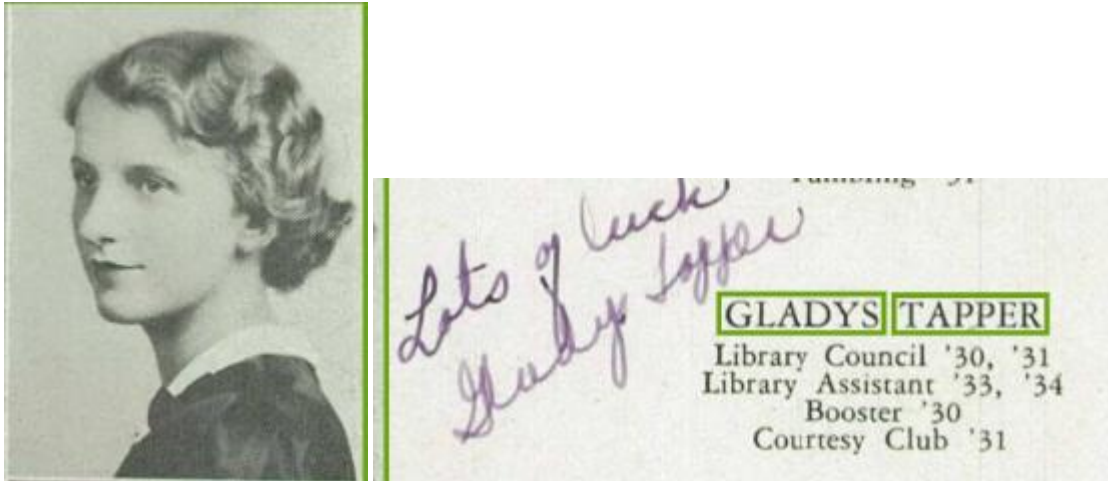

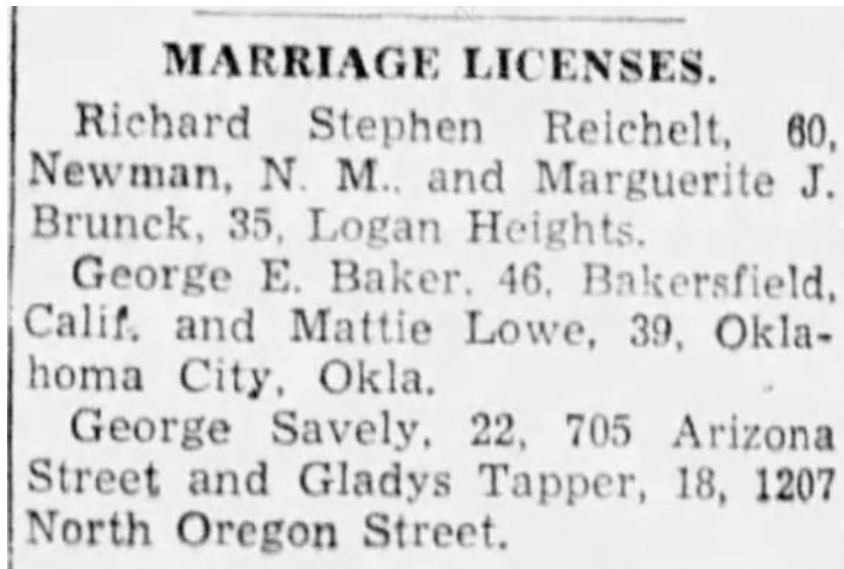

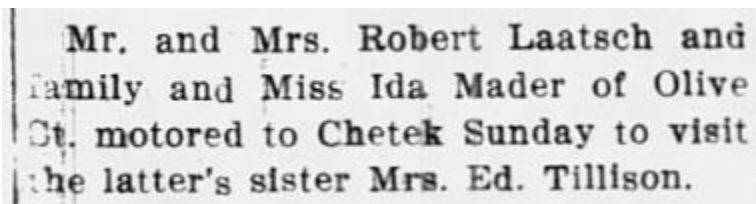


Gladys graduates from high school – “El Paso (TX) Herald-Post” Thursday 24 May 1934 p 6

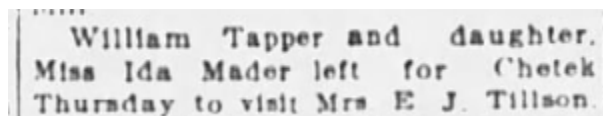


Marriage license of Gladys Tapper & George Savely – “El Paso (WI) Times” Saturday 15 Jun 1935 p 7

AURORA JAIL RECORD IS BROKEN BY BERWYN BOY

The city of Aurora, a short distance to our west, has a jail which they will be renting for costume balls, card parties, and the like since for some time they have been unable to find an occupant for any of the nice, comfortable cells contained therein.

It remained for a Berwyn youth to break the monotony of the jailer there Saturday afternoon. This youngster, who resides with his mother just north of the Illinois Central railway, was playing around the Burlington tracks when a slow moving freight came through.

The boys, all about 15 years of age, hopped aboard planning to go but a short distance. The other boys did get off but our hero, afraid lest he be injured, stayed aboard. The first stop was Aurora and the freight arrived there in the early evening. The boy got off and got himself picked up by Patrolman Harvey Mader. He was taken before Desk Sergeant George Rees where he sobbed out his story.

The Aurora police got in touch with Berwyn's department and as the mother had already reported the absence of her child, a quick connection was made between the two. A friend of the family went to Aurora and the boy was returned home, sadder but much wiser about flipping trains—even though they be slow freights.
