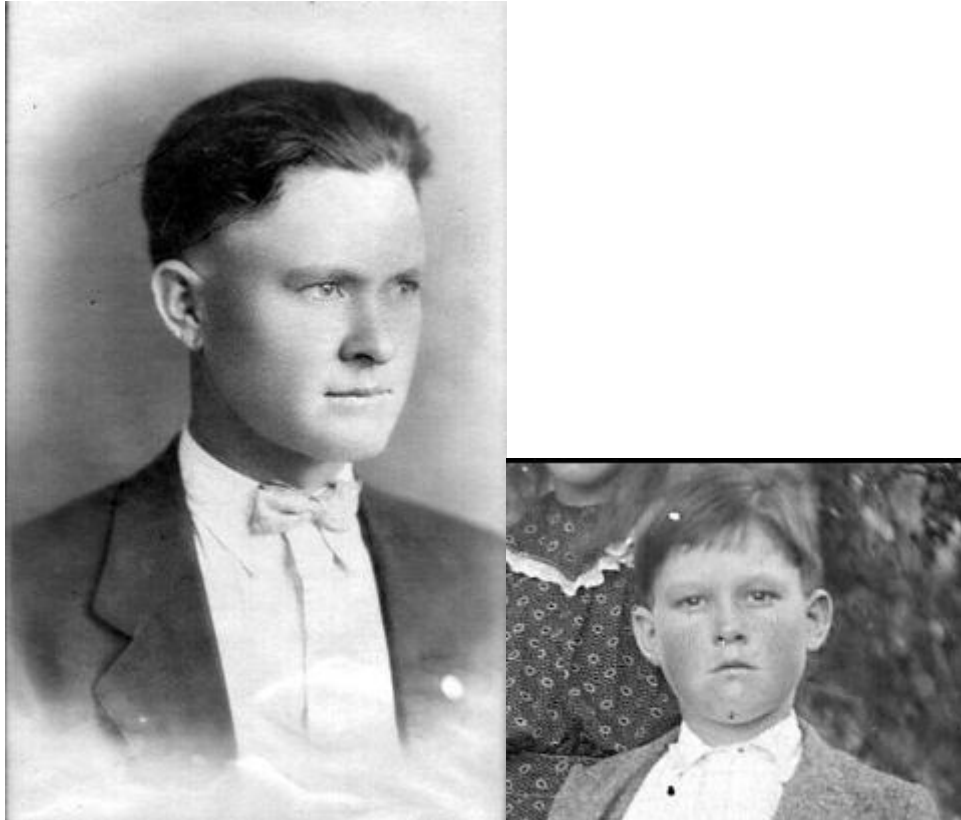

H. D. (Hub) TAYLOR

H. D. (Hub) Taylor, of Lipan, Texas, passed away at his home Dec. 21, 1960 after an illness of 6 years. He was a World War I veteran. He was wounded in the battle of Chateau- Thierry, France, for which he received the Purple Heart, and was one of 26 Texas men to receive the Silver Star.

Mr. Taylor was a brother of Mrs. J. O. Paschal of Glen Rose.

12 Texans Aboard Tuscania Recover In Irish Hospitals

By International News Service.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 25.—Sixty-three survivors, including twelve Texans and five Oklahomans of the transport Tuscania, sunk by a German submarine Feb. 5, still are in Irish hospitals, according to a cable report announced by the war department. None is in serious condition and it is expected that they will be discharged from the hospitals within a short time.

Forty of the wounded and sick men are at Londonderry, nineteen at Larne, three at Belfast and one at Dublin. Texans and Oklahomans at Londonderry follow:

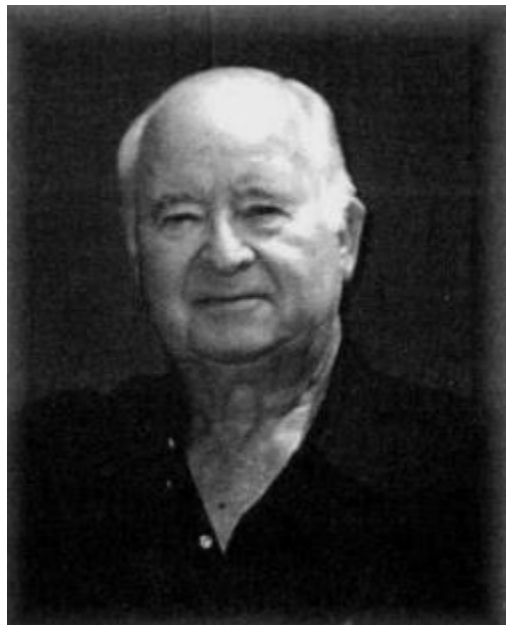

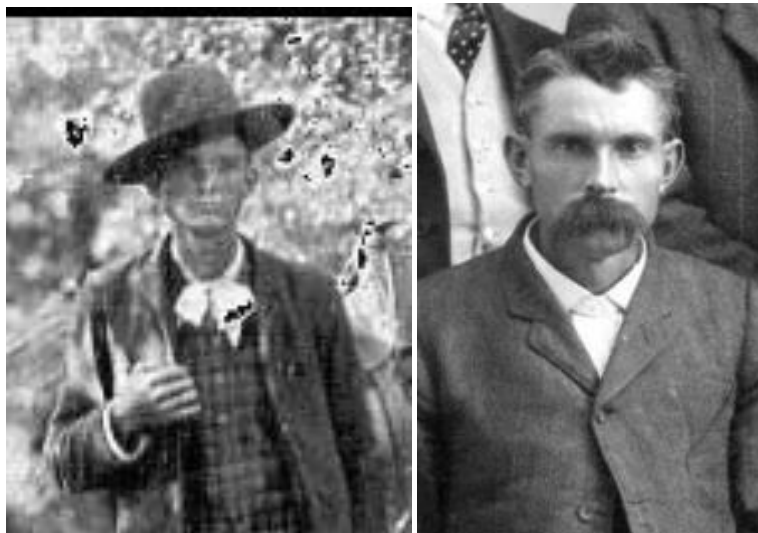

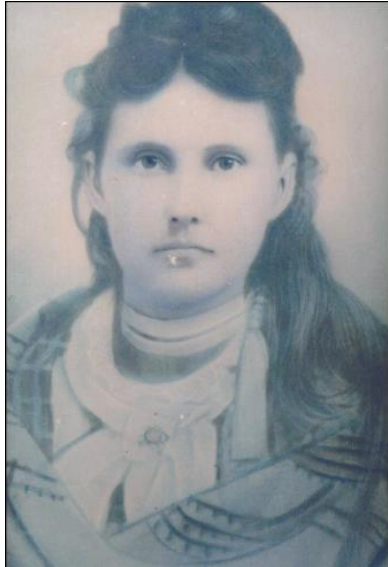
