



Tuscania survivors hospitalized in Ireland – "Houston (TX) Post" Sunday 10 Feb 1918 p 1



By International News Service. WASHINGTON, Feb. 25.-Sixtythree survivors, including twelve Texans and five Oklahomans of the transport Tuscania, sunk by a German submarine Feb. 5, still are in Irish hospitals, according to a cable report announced by the war department. None is in serious condition and it is expected that they will be discharged from the hospitals within a short time.

Forty of the wounded and sick men are at Londonderry, nineteen at Larbe, three at Belfast and one at Dublin. Texans and Oklahomans at Londenderry follow:


