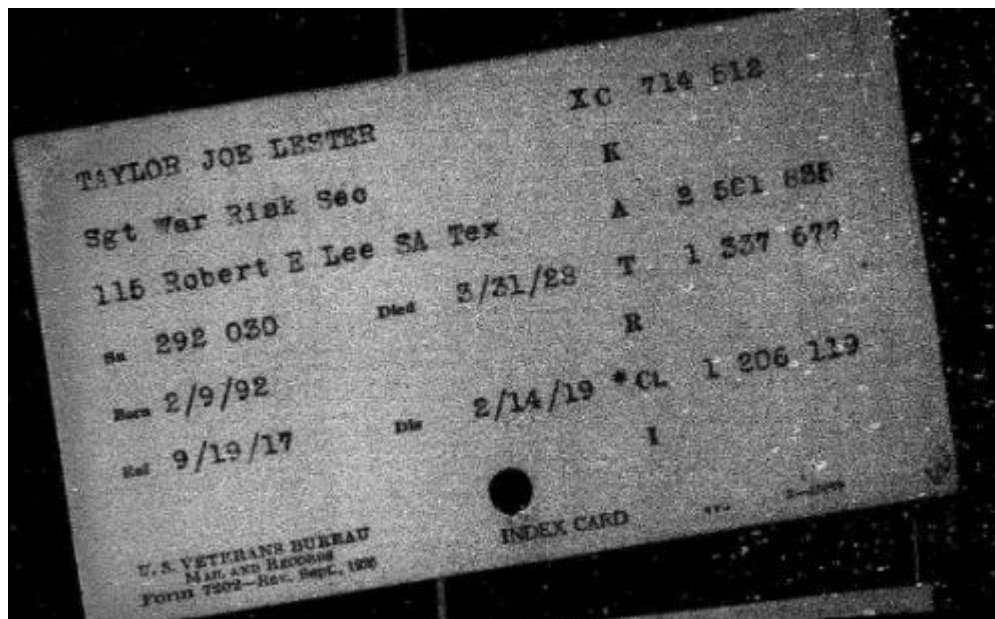

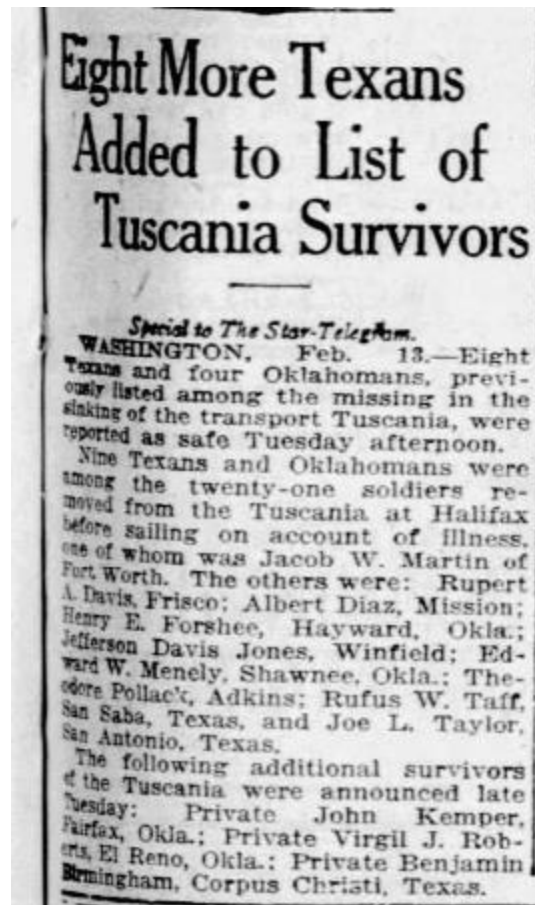

SAN ANTONIO, Texas, Feb. 11.—Sergeant Joe Lester Taylor, who was reported missing from the survivors of the ill-fated liner Tuscania, was a resident of San Antonio previous to his induction into the service by the local board for Bexar county and received his training at Camp Travis.

The safety of 21 more troopers who sailed on the Tuscania was assured by announcement of men taken from the ship at Halifax because they were ill.
