John H. Victory, 72, Dies At Gladewater; Funeral Tuesday

GLADEWATER, Nov. 1 (Spl). —Funeral services will be held at 3 p.m. Tuesday for John H. Victory, 72, pioneer railroad man, grocer, Mason, civic leader and churchman, who died early Monday. Dr. J. Wesley Smith of the College of Marshall, in which Mr. Victory was a recent regent, will officiate.

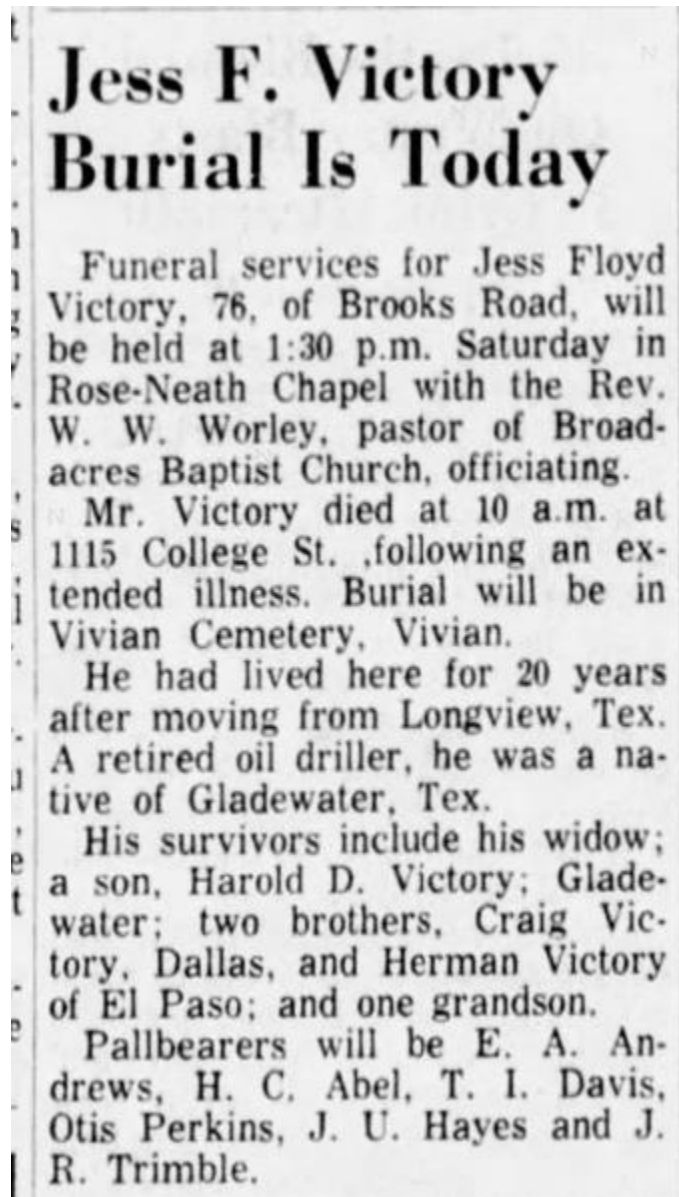
