
Four Injured In Collision

Sheriff's deputies said the accident occurred when the auto driven by Mrs. H. M. Victory attempted to pass a ear driven by Pvt. Daniel Thomas, of Fort Bliss. Thomas was attempting to turn his vehicle from the highway.




