WASHINGTON, Feb. 24.—Sixty-three American survivors of the torpedoed troop ship *Tuscania* were reported to the war department today as recovering in Irish hospitals from the effects of in-

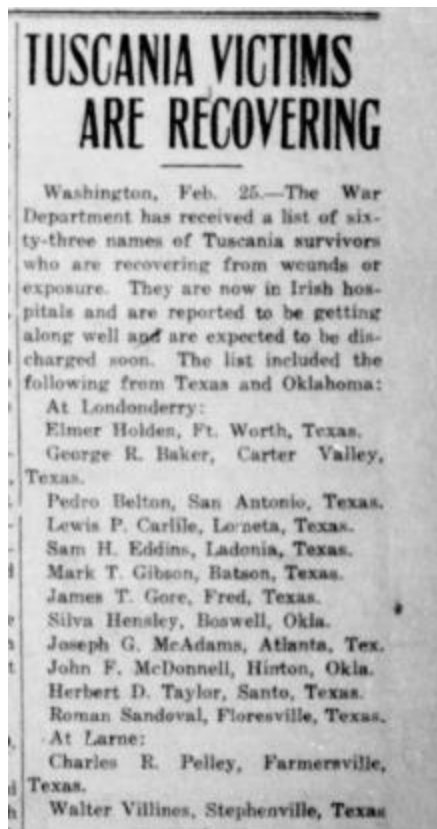
juries or exposure. The dispatch said none of the cases was serious and that it was expected all the men would soon be discharged.

All of the sixty-three had previously been reported saved and the presence of many of them in hospitals had been recorded in press dispatches, although today's dispatch brought the first official list of those in hospitals. The list included:

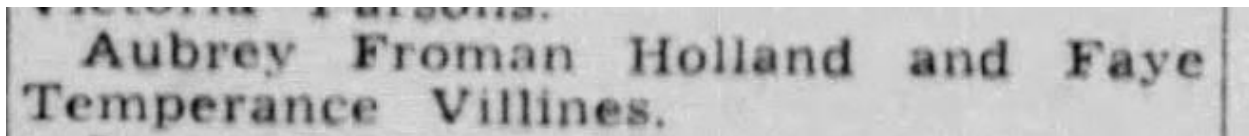
