Served in WWI in Battery B, 67th Artillery CAD, 35th Brigade in France. – Married 25 Dec 1920 in Fond du Lac, Fond du Lac WI to Elenora Antonio Zarbock (1901-1997, F: 219607603). Buried in Ledgeview Memorial Park, Fond du Lac, Fond du Lac WI. F: 219607303
- Samuel Marion Vine, 5 Dec 1889 [MI birth record] or 6 Dec 1890 {MT death record} Iron Mountain, Dickinson MI - 2 Dec 1944 Galen, Deer Lodge MT (in the Montana State Tuberculosis Sanitarium). Married Mary D. Dennison (1893 MI – 1977 MT), the daughter of Mathew Dennison & Johanna Wall, on 16 Jan 1915 in Butte, Silver Bow WI. Worked as a banker. According to their MT death certificates, Samuel & Mary are buried in Holy Cross Cemetery, Butte, Silver Bow MT but are not on Find A Grave as of 3 May 2023.
