

Cleveland Contractor Killed Diving Into Chautauqua Lake

LAKEWOOD, July 12.—A Cleveland building contractor, John Vinquist, 54, of 1273 114th St., died of a neck fracture Sunday afternoon after he dived into about three feet of water at Stow. Coroner Theodore S. Morse of Brocton issued a verdict of accidental death.

Mr. Vinquist, who was commodore of the Cleveland Heights Outboard Motor Boat Club, was visiting a cousin and her husband, Dr. and Mrs. Oscar Hannum of Bradford, Pa.

Witnesses said that Mr. Vinquist, who was not familiar with Lake Chautauqua, dived from a private pier just north of the Bemus Point-Stow Ferry pier and struck his head on the bottom of the lake. Lakewood firemen used an inhalator in an effort to revive Mr. Vinquist, who was pronounced dead by Dr. Hannum.

Stow — The first day of his vacation proved fatal to John Vinquist, 53, a Cleveland contractor who took up residence at the summer home of Dr. and Mrs. Oscar S. Hanum of Bradford, Pa.

The Cleveland man was killed Sunday afternoon when he dove into 32 inches of water here.

State Police from the Westfield and Chautauqua stations, conducted an investigation. Coroner Theodore Morse of Brocton said death was probably due to a broken neck.
