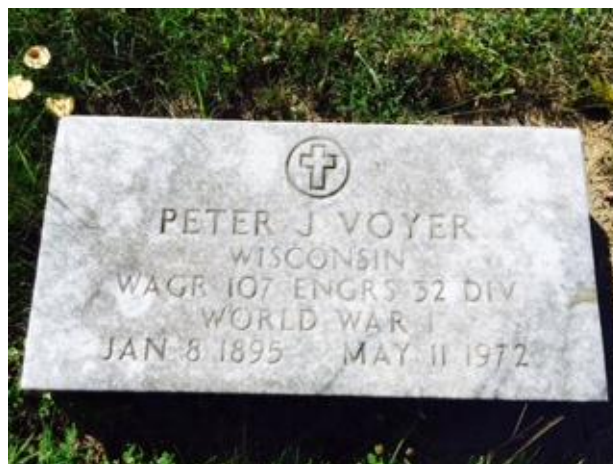

The Shell Lake Cemetery is located north of County Highway B, in the northwest corner of its intersection with Highway "K," in Bashaw Township, Washburn Co. WI – just east of the city of Shell Lake, Washburn WI.. To locate Peter's grave, enter the cemetery from Highway "B" at the westernmost of the three roads. The veterans' section is on the left (west), marked by a flagpole with the American flag, and a concrete sidewalk. To the east of the flagpole is a white-painted concrete cross dedicated to Captain Walter G. Hoar. Peter's grave is in the third row from the cross, second grave, on the north side of the sidewalk.

Peter's stone lists him as a wagoner, 107th Engineers, 32nd Division. He is buried next to his wife, Mabel Hanson Voyer.

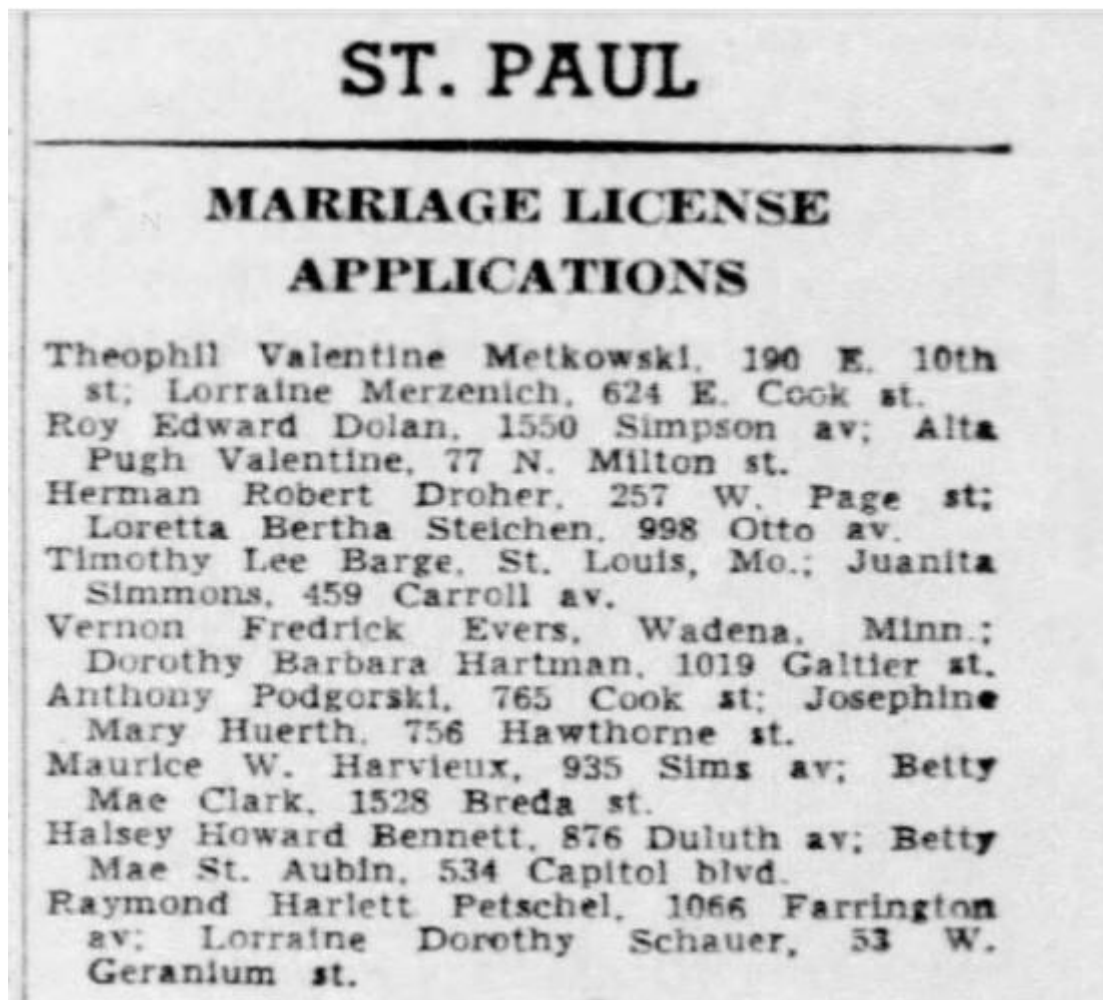

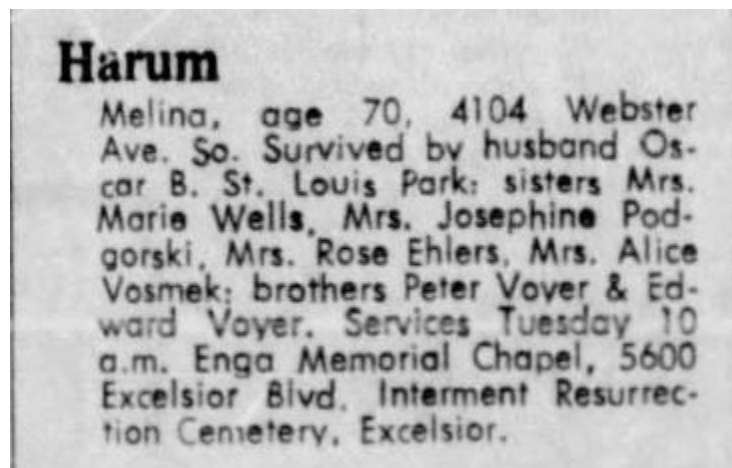

His birthplace on his WI marriage record is listed simply as “Stanford, Canada.” The 1920 census birth information agrees with the 1857 date, but in 1930, his birth year computes to 1854.

In the 1910 census, he says he emigrated to the US in 1882. In the 1920 census, he says he emigrated to the US in 1880.

Still alive in the 1930 census in Shell Lake, Washburn WI - conducted 5 April 1930.

Find A Grave:

Mother: Louise E. Guibord Voyer, 3 or 4 Apr 1872 Rice Lake, Barron WI or the Chippewa (Ojibwe) Native American reservation in Sawyer Co. (near Hayward) WI or perhaps in Cedar Lake township – 8 Dec 1961 St. Paul, Ramsey Co. MN.

Daughter of Toussaint Guibord & Eliza Nancy Eliza Ke Ji Inini {Nazi Chi Inini}, married 20 Nov 1871 Barron, Barron WI.

In the 1880 census, Louise (8 WI), lives in Cedar Lake township, Barron Co. WI with her parents.

Louise was christened at Notre Dame Church on 7 May 1872 in Chippewa Falls, Chippewa WI, along with some of her siblings (Mary Emma, born 1869 & Joseph Ernest, born 1865).

In WI marriage records, “Elisabeth’s” father is identified as “Gianini” and her mother as Ekwaiwoifen. Louise died in December 1961.

A listing of deaths in Ramsey Co. MN (headed St. Paul MN) “Minneapolis Star” 13 Dec 1961 says Louise died at age 89, a resident of 756 East Hawthorne Avenue.

Find A Grave:

Parents’ marriage: 30 Dec 1889 Oak Grove, Barron WI. This is indexed as 1887 but since the marriage record was filed Jan 1890, an 1887 date seems unlikely.

Spouse: Mabel Ida Caroline Hanson, 31 Dec 1899 Johnson township, Polk Co. MN – 5 Dec 1965 Shell Lake, Washburn WI (in the Shell Lake Hospital). Only daughter of Ole Digerness Hanson (1858-1942) & Anna Mary/Marie Olson (1866-1959). Her obituary lists her name as “Mabel Carlina” Voyer. Died at age 66. Her early life was spent in the Gully area.

Buried in Shell Lake Cemetery, Shell Lake, Washburn WI.

- George Joseph Voyer, 28 Jul 1891 Sarona, Washburn WI – 9 Dec 1964 Ramsey Co. MN. In 1910, he was a laborer at a sawmill. When he registered for the WWI draft on 29 May 1917, he was a laborer at Virginia Rainy Lake Co., Virginia MN. George served as a private first class in the U.S. Army in WWI. – In 27 Jun 1921 in Washburn Co. WI, George married Julianne Helen Hurly Voyer (16 Sep 1893 – 21 Jan 1986, F: 67255876). Buried in Section K, Site 2287, Fort Snelling National Cemetery, Minneapolis MN, F: 67080808.
- Josephine Mary Voyer Huerth Podgorski, 3 Dec 1892 WI – 3 Feb 1987 Ramsey Co. MN. SSN 471-07-8293. Josephine is a schoolteacher at the Johnnecheck School in the fall term of 1912. This school, later renamed the LaFayette School, was located in the township of Long Lake (later Madge), Washburn Co. WI, 3 miles east of Sarona WI. – Married William Huerth (1885-1965) on 17 Jun 1914 in Shell Lake, Washburn WI. – In the 1940 St. Paul, Ramsey MN census, Josephine Huerth, 47 WI, divorced was a janitree, her 3 sons lived with her. Peter's obituary in the *Spooner Advocate* 18 May 1972, lists this surviving sister as Mrs. Josephine Podgorski of St. Paul MN., Minnesota. – Wife of Anthony Podgorski (13 Oct 1892 – 20 Nov 1970, F: 3490470). She is buried in Plot N2981 with her husband in Fort Snelling National Cemetery, Minneapolis, Hennepin MN, F: 3490472
- Rose K. (Rossanna/Rosana) Voyer Ehlers, 22 Oct 1896 [or 1897] WI – 4 Sep 1977 Nobles Co. MN. SSN 477-58-5428. Her brother Peter's obituary in the *Spooner (WI) Advocate* 18 May 1972 lists this surviving sister as Mrs. Rose Ehlers [actually Ehlers] of Worthington MN. Rose Voyer married 23 Mar 1920 in Hennepin Co. MN to Albert John ("Hap") Ehlers (1896-1964, F: 170130433) in Worthington Memorial Gardens, Worthington, Nobles MN. F: 170130453
- Marie Leo/Mary/Marie Voyer Goodman/Barry Wells, 10 Aug 1898 Bashaw township, Washburn Co. WI [also found as Barron Co. WI] – May 1977. SSN 391-26-3811. Appears to have first married Harry Richmond Goodman (buried with the surname Barry) (1896 WI – 1950 IL, F: 38975024). Their son was Harry Laverne Nieman, born 28 May 1919 & apparently listed as Marie's brother, Harry Voyer, age 8 months, in the 1920 census. – Married 21 Jul 1928 in St. Louis Co. MN to Herbert Paul Nieman (1890-1950). – Peter's obituary in the *Spooner Advocate* 18 May 1972 lists this surviving sister as Mrs. Marie Wells of Milwaukee WI. She is also listed in the obituary of her sister, Melina Voyer Harum, in Jan 1971.
- Melina ("Bob") Marie Voyer Kannon Harum, May 1900 WI – Jan 1971 MN. Her nickname "Bob" is inscribed on her tombstone. – Melina Marie Voyer married on 12 Nov 1919 in Hennepin Co. MN to John Ralph Kannon. Married 30 Jan 1924 in Hennepin Co. MN to Oscar Benjamin Harum. The obituary for Melina Voyer Harum appears in the "Minneapolis Star" 4 Jan 1971, p 27. She dies at age 70 & was residing at 4104 Webster Avenue South, St. Louis Park MN with husband Oscar Benjamin ("Ben") Harum (1896-1973, F: 30044317). Surviving are her sisters Mrs. Marie Wells, Mrs. Josephine Podgorski, Mrs. Rose Ehlers and Mrs. Alice

Vosmek, plus brothers Peter and Edward Voyer. –She is interred in Resurrection Cemetery, Shorewood, Hennepin MN. F: 30044340.

- Frank Xavier (Frankie) Voyer, 8 Jul 1904 Sarona, Washburn WI – 5 Oct 1967 Portland, Multnomah OR. SSN 559-16-6100. Never married. His veteran tombstone is inscribed “Wisconsin Sgt 565 Ord Das Co, WWII, Korean.” Buried in Willamette National Cemetery, Portland, Multnomah OR. F: 3941911
- Edward Isaiac/Isaac Voyer, 14 Aug 1907 Shell Lake, Washburn WI – 15 May 1991 Hennepin Co. MN. He served in the US Navy in WWII. When his brother Peter died in 1972, Edward was living in Los Angeles CA. Buried in St. Joseph’s Cemetery, Shell Lake, Washburn WI. F: 168550601.
- Alice Louise Voyer Vosmek, 30 Jul 1909 Shell Lake, Washburn WI – 29 Apr 2009 Minneapolis, Hennepin MN. She was the widow of Stanley Vosmek. Peter’s obituary in the *Spooner (WI) Advocate* 18 May 1972 lists this surviving sister as Mrs. Alice Vosnek instead of Vosmek, a resident of Excelsior MN. Alice’s obituary in the *Minneapolis Star Tribune* 2 May 2009 indicated she had been preceded in death by 4 brothers and 4 sisters. This notice may have missed some of her siblings. Her husband is buried with the name Stan Vosmek (F: 30138701). Buried in Resurrection Cemetery, Shorewood, Hennepin MN. F: Her husband is buried as Stan Vosmek (Find A Grave 30138701). The other side of his headstone has Alice’s name & birth year of 1909; rest is blank.
- ? Laverne/Javerne Voyer, summer 1919 WI - Male. Listed as 8 months old when the 1920 census was taken in Shell Lake, Washburn WI on 5 March 1920. Although labeled as the son of George & Louise, she was age 48 and a bit old for bearing children. Believe this is the son of Marie L. Voyer, Harry Laverne Voyer, b. 28 May 1919 in Minneapolis, Hennepin MN [or WI?], died 12 Sep 1999 Hennepin Co. MN, who later used the surname of Marie’s first husband, Herbert Paul Nieman.

Notes:

Peter’s maternal grandparents, Toussaint and Eliza Guibord, had 12 children.

Toussaint was the son of Pierre & Adelaide Guibord. Toussaint immigrated to the U.S. from Canada in 1857. He may be the Toussaint Guibord, age 13, born circa 1838, residing in St. Jacques, East Quebec, Leinster County in the 1851 Canada census. His birth year might be 1841.

When Louise’s brother Ernest Guibord married Maggie Redmond Quaderen on 5 Jun 1901 in Barron Co. WI, both Ernest and Maggie are listed as “mixed white and Indian.”

The first name of Peter’s grandmother, Eliza, has been found as Nancy Eliza, Elisa, Liza, Elija & Elisabeth. Her surname has been found spelled Chinnex, Zeminie, Janinie, Guimer, Gianini, Cheninay, Ghinins, Shunny & Ke Je Inini. Eliza was supposedly born in 1845 & died 9 May 1932 (according to findagrave.com 107752055) and is maybe buried in Reserve, Sawyer Co. WI Wisconsin.

Ancestry.com records list Eliza’s father as Ke Ji Inini (1804-1895) and her mother as Na Wa Ke Migokwe (1808-1869). In the 1900 census, when the family is living in Cedar Lake township, Barron County, Wisconsin, Toussaint is identified by race as “white” while Eliza is identified as “Indian,” born on the “Courtonilles Reservation,” presumably a misspelling of the Lac Courte Oreilles reservation of the Ojibwe tribe.

Prosper Guibord, Eliza's younger brother, is featured in the book *Wisconsin Chippewa Myths and Tales And Their Relation to Chippewa Life*, by Victor Barnouw (University of Wisconsin Press, 1977, Appendix B, pages 261-262, found at:

Prosper, who contributed three tales to the book, was interviewed in 1942 at age 67. Prosper, who was bilingual, served as an interpreter for author Barnouw and his three anthropology colleagues. Prosper said he had been born in Barron County WI about seven miles east of Rice Lake. His father Toussaint was a Frenchman who came down from Canada for logging and married an Indian girl. After she died in childbirth, he married another Indian girl, age 13. This would appear to be Eliza. Until Prosper, their fourth child, was age 12, the Guibord family lived in a cabin of hewn white oak logs (circa 1887), then his father built a frame house and became a farmer.

Toussaint & Eliza "Janinie" were married 20 Nov 1871 in Barron, Barron Co. WI. The marriage record lists Toussaint's parents as Pierre & Adelaide Guibord, while Eliza's parents are listed as John & Adel Janinie. Three of their children, including Louise, had already been born prior to this marriage date. In the 1900 census, the couple says they have been married 36 years (therefore, circa 1874). A second Wisconsin marriage record (or perhaps the recording of a marriage ceremony needed to comply with a legal requirement) gives a marriage date of January 23, 1904, between Toussaint Guibord (born in Quebec, son of Peter Guibord) and Eliza Shunny, a Chippewa Indian, born on the reservation, Sawyer County, Wisconsin. Eliza's father is listed as John Shunny and her mother as Newaquaning Cuocee Court D'Oervilles, with the "Courte Oreilles" presumably being the name of the reservation and not the final part of her mother's surname.

Toussaint Guibord supposedly died in 1915. He was alive at the time of the 1910 U.S. census, when, at age 71, born circa 1839, he was living with his nephew, Prosper Forrest, in Couderay (Sawyer County), where Forrest, a widower, was a saloonkeeper. Toussaint's status is "married."

Pre-war:

The *Spooner (WI) Register* of 4 May 1901 noted that George Voyer & family left the area Sunday to visit friends and relatives at Dobie WI.

"Spooner (WI) Register" 25 May 1901 reported Mrs. Voyer's two-day "shopping expedition" to Rice Lake, Barron WI.

"Spooner (WI) Register" 14 Sep 1901 - Sarona news column: "Geo. Voyer is doing his duty as a farmer, plowing."

Spooner (WI) Register of 19 Oct 1901 reports that George Voyer is working on road maintenance using his team. "He says there is a little more satisfaction in working on the road for \$8 a day than working on the section [the railroad] for \$1.25 per day."

Spooner (WI) Register, 2 Nov 1901 – George Voyer is recorded as purchasing another 40 acres of land.

Spooner (WI) Register of 4 Jan 1902 notes that George Voyer is hauling logs to the sawmill.

“*Spooner (WI) Register*” 2 May 1903 – George Voyer is “loading staves for Mrs. Turner.”

Spooner (WI) Advocate of 23 Nov 1906 offers 16-inch maple wood for sale by George Voyer for \$1.75 a cord.

“*Spooner (WI) Advocate*” 11 Mar 1910 – George Voyer was paid \$6 for “team drawing wood” by the Washburn County WI Board of Supervisors.

Wartime:

Draft registration (FLM 1674998) on 5 Jun 1917: Peter Voyer, age 22, common laborer. Not currently employed but going to work for L. Bohn of Shell Lake. He has brown eyes & dark brown hair, is tall and of stout build. On his draft registration card, Peter answered “No sir” when asked if he wished to claim exemption from the draft. Peter registered for the draft on 5 Jun 1917, the national registration day, in the village of Shell Lake, Washburn WI, which was listed on the front page of the *Spooner (WI) Advocate*, 22 Jun 1917.

Peter's World War I registration – June 5, 1917

Peter held Washburn County conscription number 623. In the draft number lottery held on July 20, 1917; this number ranked #1144. According to his Veterans Administration Military Index card, Peter enlisted July 24, 1917.

Peter was 23 years old the day the *Tuscania* sank. He sailed listed as "Peter Voyer," a private in the 107th Engineer Train, listing his mother, Mrs. George Voyer of Shell Lake WI, as his next-of-kin.

In *Tuscania* survivor & fellow Spoonerite Fred Taylor's letter to his mother written 29 Dec 918, Fred recounts how he & Peter Voyer, at the Second Battle of the Marne, ate a lunch of corned beef, sitting on a pile of lumber - surrounded by lots of dead German soldiers.

Again listed as Peter Voyer, he sailed home aboard *Haverford*, which left Brest, France, on 4 May 1919 & arrived in Philadelphia PA on 18 May 1919. A wagoner in the 107th Engineer Train, he recorded his mother, Mrs. Louise Voyer of Shell Lake WI, as his next-of-kin. His serial number was 251,731.

His Veterans Administration Military Index card indicates he was discharged 27 May 1919.

In Jan 1920, Peter Voyer is among the wagoners of the 32nd Division to be cited for his bravery in a Sep 1918 action. Peter, along with Ernest L. Bowman (the cousin of Peter's fellow *Tuscania* survivor Fred Taylor) & P.C. Rice, receive a citation for bravery for their work as wagoners in the Sep 1918 action at the Oise-Aisne Canal & Ailette River in rebuilding the destroyed Gourson Bridge, allowing the Allies to advance.

Post-war:

Lived in Minneapolis, Hennepin MN, where he was married in 1928, until returning to Shell Lake, Washburn WI in 1931.

By the time of the 1930 census, Peter listed his occupation as bricklayer. His obituary states that he was a bricklayer by trade, and that he belonged to Bricklayer Union Local 19. He was also a member of the Francis Bergin-Paul Nieman American Legion Post No. 225 of Shell Lake, Washburn WI.

Obituary:

Besides his two daughters & sons-in-law, Peter was survived by six grandchildren, two great-grandchildren, one brother and four sisters.

Peter Voyer died at age 77 in a nursing home in St. Paul, Ramsey MN. His funeral was held Monday, 14 May 1972, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Shell Lake, Washburn WI, with Rev. Fr. Paul Boshold officiating. Military honors were accorded at his gravesite in the Shell Lake Cemetery by member of the American Legion Post of Shell Lake. His military service is listed on his tombstone.
