

Tamme Jans Koster, the son of Jan Pieters Tammes Koster & Asitje Jans Dijkhuis, was born 29 Dec 1841 in Hornhuizen, De Marne, Groningen, Netherlands & died 1 May 1882 in Spring Lake, Ottawa Co. MI. Eight children are listed on an Ancestry.com family tree. Tamme & Grietje Koster immigrated with no children, departing on 3 May 1867 from Kloosterburen, De Marne, Groningen, Netherlands, arriving in NYC on 20 May 1867 aboard "City of Boston." Tamme Koster is buried in Spring Lake, Ottawa Co. MI but the grave is unmarked. Greitje is buried as Grietje Koster, in a plot purchased by Jacob VanderLaan, in Spring Lake Cemetery, Spring Lake, Ottawa Co. MI.
